

If you would like Eucharistic Adoration to be extended later than 7:00 so that you could more easily come, please let Fr. Coon know by calling him in the Parish Office at 624-7333.
- If you are looking for a real spiritual shot in the arm in your relationship with our Lord, Cursillo is a wonderful opportunity. It is an opportunity to deepen your relationship with Christ and help understand God's purpose for you. Are you wanting to learn more about how your faith fits into your everyday life? All men and women of the diocese are invited to take a time of retreat with the Lord to explore these questions and more. There will be a Men's Cursillo the evening of Thursday Feb. 24th to the afternoon of Sunday the 27th, and there will be a Women's Cursillo the evening of Thursday March the 24th to the afternoon of Sunday the 27th. Both will be held at Pinecrest Camp and Convention Center located about five miles south of Fredericktown. Feel free to talk with Fr. if you have any questions or need more information.
