We will close the 3-year National Eucharistic Revival with a Mass and Procession on the Feast of Corpus Christi. Here are the details:

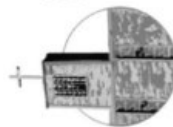
When: Sunday, June 22, 2025


