

FROM THE PASTORS DESK

"Would you please pray for me?" I hope each of us is getting requests for prayer from our family and friends. If not, the way to elicit prayers is to ask for them: "Is there anything I can pray for you?"



Prayer is not magic, us controlling God, like a magic incantation that aims to move God's will to something against it. Nor is prayer worthless, like hopeful thinking. Prayer is conversation, the communication between ourselves and God and one another. Much like any human relationship, this request should be experienced like two friends, one who asks for a favor, or offers thanks, or gives praise, or repents for a sin to the other. Good friends trust one another, listen to each other, ask for help, and build each other up.

With God, his love is so perfect that he does not need anything from us to be more perfect or more happy or more fulfilled. Rather, God's love is pure gift, generous love, not because we have earned it but because he wants our good. When we pray, we ought to approach God with this image: a lovingly held child asking a good father, who loves every word. He may or may not give us what we want, for he knows all things and knows what will truly be best for us. No prayer goes unheard, even if the response is not what we expect or hope for.

It is very important that we pray for one another. When someone is sick, or sad, or suffering, or rejoicing, or blessed, we ought to be in constant communication with God about it. Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18). God can act without our intercession, but there is something beautiful about the Body of Christ acting in love for one another, gifting one another with prayer God may be waiting because one more act of love from us is on its way, a prayer from a grandchild for his grandpa, a desperate husband for the salvation of his wife, and your prayer for whomever you are feeling inspired to pray for this day.

Most of our parishes have "prayer chains" to add your petitions. These are great tools to build up communion and the gift of prayer. Please use them often. Of course, the intentions added should be kept private to all members of the chain and never become a topic of conversation outside of the individual prayer to God. Some people have told me they are afraid to add their name to the prayer chain because they are afraid of "everyone talking about me." Gossip is a sin, and that qualifies. When a name is added, whether or not a description is included with the request, we should never need to ask "what for?". God knows the need, so our gift of love is enough.

I'm praying for you. Please pray for me.



Sacred Heart School News

January 30th - February 4th



Is it a school with a parish, or is it a parish with a school? It is a question I always consider when people ask me about Catholic Schools Week, though you might look at that opening question and ask, "What?"

It is a good question, because our parish communities have a mandate from the Gospel to preach the good news. Moreover, that is exactly what a good Catholic school does. It is another one of the ministries of a parish: to educate well-rounded individuals in Gospel values, preparing those young individuals to take their eventual place in the larger secular community. All the educational efforts of the parish school are focused on the life of faith. That faith is formed in knowledge of the teachings of the Church and of the Gospel, and those qualities are demonstrated through a life of service to the community.

A Catholic school is a community of faith, knowledge, and service, as a ministry of the parish community; and Catholic Schools Week provides a wonderful opportunity for us to reflect on whether we have "a school with a parish, or a parish with a school," and make sure our parish school is living its mandate from the Church.



It's that time of year again, the Catholic United Financial Raffle. This is the 2nd biggest fundraiser for our school so it is important that everyone participates to help us reach our \$30,000 goal. Every student, K-6, is required to raise \$300 per school year between the work-a-thon and the raffle. Sacred Heart Area School families will continue to be available to sell Catholic United Financial Raffle tickets after the weekend Masses across the ACC.

The Challenge Grant is well under way and I am so thankful for the outpouring of support from our many alumni, parents, and all of you who support Catholic schools. I wanted to take some time to give you a quick update on where our fund currently stands. We are so close to finishing up our goal of \$25,000! We currently have a little more than \$21,000 of designated "new money" donated to this cause, so another \$4,000 is all we need to reach our \$25,000 goal before March 31, 2022. Once again I am blown away by the outpouring of love and support from the SHAS community. Many of our alumni sent little notes with their offerings, full of support and thankfulness for the Catholic education they received. Know that your contribution will help continue that education for our future generation as they grow into lay and religious leaders in our Church.

Deadline is March 31st, 2022. The donation should be 'tagged' as for the Challenge Grant.

First Corinthians and the Stewardship of Social Media

"Love is patient, love is kind ..." As familiar as these words are, they never seem to stray into the territory of becoming trite or silly. At their core they communicate a truth about us and about our Creator that never fails to inspire. But despite the fact that you've probably heard it at many weddings over time, First Corinthians isn't just for newlyweds. It wasn't written for married folks. It's for every single one of us, in every state of life and every social situation, in every country and culture and language across the globe. Which means that First Corinthians is even for the online world. It's for Facebook and Twitter and Instagram and all the other platforms I'm forgetting (there seems to be a new one every day, doesn't there?).

A sense of division — whether rooted in politics, culture or anything else — is growing in our world, and it's never more obvious than when we observe interactions online. It is far easier, after all, to remember what love is when a human being of flesh and blood stands before us. When all we see is an avatar or a profile picture on a screen — especially accompanied by an opinion with which we vehemently disagree — even the most loving Christians can throw First Corinthians out the window.

As everyday stewards we know that we are charged to be not only gracious but grateful. We receive others but we also give thanks for what they bring to us — even if that's an opportunity to "strive eagerly for the greatest spiritual gifts."

So before the next time you post anything online, I suggest giving First Corinthians a read — and remember, love never fails. — Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS
