

We were able to acquire two retired priests to assist our ACC on Easter Sunday: Father Tom Becker and Father Geno Doyle. Each priest will have two Masses, organized in such a way that they can travel safely and in a timely manner. The times are not ideal, but they will provide for our needs.

Having four priests for Easter is a blessing, one that we will not always have every year, so I want to encourage you to invite as many people to Easter Sunday Mass as possible. Let's fill the churches to maximum capacity, justifying the need to ask for help in the future!

Likewise, the Sacred Triduum–three holy days preceding Easter Sunday–are some of the most sacred days of our faith: the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, the Passion & Cross on Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil of Holy Saturday. With eight parishes of people joining together at two to three sites (Bluffton, Staples & Wadena), the pews ought to be full. Please prioritize these days in your calendar every year. Unless there is a major reason not to, every Catholic should participate in the Triduum every year, not just a few times in a lifetime.

In the past, I have encouraged parishioners, "Make sure you attend the Triduum in its totality at least once every three years, so that it remains important and you allow God to speak through those special liturgies." I am now asking more of us. If Catholics do not attend them, we forget who we are, who God is, how much he loved us and sacrificed for us. Celebrating only Christmas and Easter without the fullness of the passion is deceiving ourselves about the gospel.

Furthermore, if we do not rally together as an ACC, and instead we choose to not attend the Triduum resulting in low crowd sizes, it will only justify hosting them in only two locations in the future. We have the choice to fill the pews to overflowing, to share together with joint-choirs, joint-liturgical ministries, joint-prayer, and to celebrate as a Community our faith in Jesus Christ to its fullness.







STAPLES AREA FOOD SHELF - MARCH FOOD SHARE MONTH

The Staples Area Food Shelf would like to call attention to the Annual March Food Share Month. During March, Minnesota Food shelves conduct their major campaign for funds and food shelf items. The funds and food collected help determine our budget for the coming year. All funds and food items collected in March help determine the grant amounts available from Hunger Solutions of Minnesota. The non-donated items are purchased from Second Harvest Heartland Food Bank in Brooklyn Park, Ernie's Market and Jon's Family Foods in Staples.

While the COVID Pandemic has also had an impact on our Staples Area Food Shelf, and our usage numbers, have gone down} they are returning to normal and we look forward to assisting all those who experience food insecurities.

Besides the foods, we also provide other household necessities such as toilet paper, laundry and dishwashing soap, and personal hygiene items.
