

Our ACC Pastoral Council has been working on a parishioner engagement survey that we wish to administer beginning next weekend, from April 16-24th. The purpose of the survey is for long-range planning regarding weekend and daily Mass schedules, as well as to learn which of our ACC forms of communication are effectively being used by parishioners. Every parishioner Confirmation age or older is requested to fill out either an online or paper version of the survey during that time and return it to either ACC Office in Staples or Wadena.

Last Spring 2021, we had a limited amount of time to organize a schedule for Masses in the ACC, and the result was challenging for all of the parishes, and painful for several. At the time, I said that our ACC Pastoral Council would revisit our schedule over the winter months of 2022, to evaluate our needs and try to provide a better schedule for the long-term, if needed. Next week's survey is part of our discernment process, so your feedback will be most helpful. Please be honest and caring with your responses, and only fill out one version of the survey, so that the results are the most accurate and fair.

We have great parishes, and our Pastoral Council is interested in providing the best for each and all, knowing that arranging one Mass per parish on the weekends is no easy task for eight parishes and two priests. Many factors contribute to the complexity of discernment: reasonable times of day for Mass, social and sacramental times before and after Masses, driving times and distances, meal options for the clergy, seating capacities of locations, largest crowds at premier times, and balancing availability within the territory of the ACC.

The plan moving forward will be to gather the results of the survey, learn what we can from them to further evaluate our Mass time schedules, and come up with any changes that may need to be made for a more favorable schedule. I imagine that any changes would take effect many months from now, rather than to do so too soon.

The already established plan to switch Mass times between the parishes of St. Hubert, Bluegrass and St. Michael, Motley for the weekend of May 7-8, 2022, will still take effect. This will help accommodate the summer lake crowds around the Motley area.

Please pray for our ACC and parishes. I am praying for you.

Holy Week "Cheat Sheet" - catholicicing.com

**Palm Sunday:** Liturgical color, red. Jesus rides a donkey into Jerusalem, the people wave palm branches at him shouting "Hosanna".

**Holy Monday:** Liturgical color, purple. Jesus and his disciples go into the temple, and Jesus overturns the tables since people are selling things rather than praying there.

**Holy Tuesday:** Liturgical color, purple. Jesus and the disciples return to the temple and teach the people many things with parables and give the people the new commandment.

Holy Wednesday (AKA Spy Wednesday): Liturgical color, purple. Judas agrees to hand over Jesus for 30 pieces of silver.

**Holy Thursday:** Liturgical color, white. Jesus has the Last Supper, which is the institution of the Eucharist and also the first mass. He also washes the feet of his disciples. Jesus asks his disciples to pray in the garden with him all night, and they fall asleep.

**Good Friday:** Liturgical color, black. Jesus dies on the cross. All the things from the stations of the cross happen this day.

**Holy Saturday:** Jesus is dead in the tomb. The evening of Holy Saturday is considered the "vigil", and Easter celebrating can begin then.

#### Question:

#### Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.
