

For April 24, 2022 - Divine Mercy Sunday

The Lord is Mercy. Beloved, let us love one another, because love is of God; everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God. Whoever is without love does not know God, for God is love (1 John 4:7-8). The Bible teaches us that God's way is mercy.

The kingdom of God is love. The reign of God is love. The activity of God is strong and patient love. Creation is the fruit of love (Genesis 1 & 2). Human beings are made in God's image and likeness, which is love. The Bible is the story of the forming of covenants of love between God and his people (Gen 1-2, 6-9, 12, 15, 17; Ex 20-34; Deut 5-11; 2 Sam 7; Jer 31:31; Luke 22:20; Heb 9:15, 12:24). Even when human beings fail to be God's image and likeness by sinning against God and one another, God calls us back to the relationship of love that he intends us to have and be. And in the fullness of time, out of love for us, God sends his only-begotten Son to save us (John 3:16). There is no greater love, for he has laid down his life for us, his friends (John 15:13).

The Church is to be all of this for every soul. When we gather together, it is a meeting of misery and mercy. We, in our misery, turn to our God, who is mercy, and seek consolation from the One with whom "all things are possible" (Matthew 19:26). We are indeed a community of sinners and saints, hypocrites and holy persons, all in need of salvation from sin and death. No one should use the excuse that they avoid the Church because there are too many sinners. We always have room for one more.

Our call as disciples is to be ambassadors of mercy, "as if God were appealing through us" (2 Corinthians 3:6, 5:20). The world around us is falling into severe loneliness from division, isolation and fear. It is rising up in violence, arrogance, greed, selfishness, opinionated rhetoric, dissolution of truth, and aggressive movements for collective association unto itself in direct opposition to the way of Christ, the kingdom of God, the reign of mercy and love. And our own Catholic kin are struggling to hold on to religious faith while tempted to acedia & sloth, that is the resistance to do good and avoid evil. It is a real-life struggle between hell and heaven before our eyes, and if we are honest and sober-minded about the gravity of our circumstances, we can say with trepidation that souls are going to hell right in front of us. They already are living it, and what will magically change after physical death if love does not replace sin, if misery does not accept mercy?

We must cry out: "Come to the Church to encounter mercy! God forgives all! God has conquered over sin and death! Be baptized into his household! Receive reconcili-

ation and healing in the Sacraments of Confession and Anointing of the Sick!" Let those who fear the Lord say, "His mercy endures forever!" (Psalm 118).

The monthly Grief Support Group at St. Hubert Parish will be held on the 2nd Wednesday of the month following Mass and fellowship in the church basement.



The World Is Watching

If you're a parent, you know this to be true: the world is watching. All it takes is one slip-up — one bad word, one selfish action, one uncharitable commentary, and that's the thing your child seems to notice.

When he or she calls you on it, the only thing you can do is come clean. "Yep, I did that," you have to say. "I'm a work in progress, but luckily, God never stops working."

I think it's fair to say that we don't think enough about the wounds of Christ. It's a little understandable, of course. Our human bodies flinch at the sight of such pain and mortification. It's a lot to handle, the physical trauma of a crucifixion. It carries an R rating in a PG world.

But the wounds of Christ are the only thing that could make Thomas believe. Literally nothing else was so powerful, not even the testimony of his most trusted friends. Only by looking at and feeling the torn flesh — by beholding that messy reality — did this Apostle, this actual companion of Christ, come to believe in the Resurrection.

"Christ has no body now but yours," goes the famous quote attributed to St. Teresa of Avila. What she's saying is that we have become the means through which God chooses to accomplish His will in the world. Us, the broken. Us, the weary. Us, the imperfect. Yes, miraculous events and apparitions still occur from time to time, but by and large, if a person is going to come to believe in Jesus Christ in this day and age, it will be because of something we Christians do or say.

Christ has no wounds now but ours. Our brokenness, our weariness, our imperfection — our reality. It all belongs to him, and the world is watching.

Take A Stand Against Anytime, Anywhere Gambling

A bill that would bring commercial sports gambling to Minnesota is currently moving through the legislative process. This is not charitable gaming! We're talking about a major cultural shift. H.F. 778 would make gambling easy and accessible 24/7 from any computer or smartphone—and the potential losses are massive for players and their children.

Now we need YOUR voice to stop this insidious bill.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 2413) states that games of chance (card games, bingo, etc.) or wagers are not in themselves contrary to justice. But it also warns that "the passion for gambling risks becoming an enslavement," and that wagers "become morally unacceptable when they deprive someone of what is necessary to provide for his needs and those of others."

Act Now:

Encourage your legislator to protect our state's common good by taking a stand against the sportsbooks and multinational casino conglomerates who will pad their pockets with Minnesotans' losses!


