

For May 8, 2022 - Fourth Sunday of Easter

How do you spend your time? Do you give the first fruits of your time to those who matter most: your family at home, and your family of God and His Church?

Time is the one resource that is not renewable. We have now, and then it is gone. Most of us are blessed to live at least to retirement age, usually spending the vast majority of our time on earth building for the future. We go to school to get ready for a career. We lay the foundations of our career in order to settle down and have a family. We spend the family years building for retirement and to send our children for education and to build the foundations of their careers. Then we settle into retirement in order to ... do any number of things before we are laid to rest. With that timeline focused on the future we ought to ask, "What are my priorities? Am I giving the best part of my life in the present to the people around me now or to some future version of us that may or may not come about?" Unfortunately, many people regret not having invested time in what truly matters in the here and now, only coming to this realization when a tragedy strikes, or a marriage is on the rocks, or they are about to meet their maker.

The truth is, deep down, we all want great quality time with our spouse, our children and family. Love, friendship, vulnerability, the capacity to be at peace with another in the same room for long periods of time, the freedom to stare deep into each other's eyes at length without feeling ashamed, afraid, or overwhelmed, these things do not happen automatically. They are virtuous habits built on trust over time. They involve lots of forgiveness & reconciliation to work out misunderstandings and the damage of sins, and an overall desire to know the other intimately in divine love and to want their good for their sake. In some regard, heaven is and will be eternal quality time with the ones who matter most, presuming we want to be around them forever, otherwise it will be hell. And this is the point: will I want to be around God and my family forever if I do not already do so now? If work is more important, or school, or sports, or entertainment, or whatever, then what will change just because the season of life ends and a new one begins, especially if all of those other things are stripped away and all that is left are those whom I was called to love?

The quality of a mutual loving relationship is a result of priorities and choices. This week, spend some time reflecting on those relationships that matter most to you, and make a choice to prioritize them.


