

In 1992, the US Bishops wrote a document entitled: "Stewardship: A Disciple's Response." It provides keen insights into what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ as Catholics. I strongly recommend reading it online or ordering a copy to read during your holy hour each week. Even 15 minutes a day of spiritual reading (instead of videos or television) is a great way to grow in one's faith as an adult.

The document begins with three convictions: 1. "Mature disciples make a conscious, firm decision, carried out in action, to be followers of Jesus Christ no matter the cost to themselves."

2. "Beginning in conversion, change of mind and heart, this commitment is expressed not in a single action, nor even in a number of actions over a period of time, but in an entire way of life. It means committing one's very self to the Lord."

3. "Stewardship is an expression of discipleship, with the power to change how we understand and live out our lives. Disciples who practice stewardship recognize God as the origin of life, the giver of freedom, the source of all they have and are and will be. They are deeply aware of the truth that 'The Lord's are the earth and its fullness; the world and those who dwell in it' (Psalm 24:1). They know themselves to be recipients and caretakers of God's many gifts. They are grateful for what they have received and eager to cultivate their gifts out of love for God and one another."

My questions to you, as parishioners of our Area Catholic Community of Mary, Mother of the Church: 1. Are you satisfied with the level of maturity of discipleship in our parishes regarding active participation in liturgy, social events, volunteering, and outreach?

2. Are you satisfied with the quality of our culture in the local Catholic community?

If not, there are ways for us to change things, but they require sacrifice of our time and talent to do so. A personal commitment to hospitality, prayer, formation, and service as a 'way of life' in Jesus Christ will change the culture. When we are a people fully alive in gratitude to God, "willing the good of the other for their sake" (St. Thomas Aquinas on 'love'), then we will be the kinds of good stewards we know we are called to be.

Start with time. Focus on small habits that build up family life and relationship with God, as I wrote about the last two weeks. Have you been spending quality time with your family and friends? Have you been giving God the first fruits of your day in prayer? Conscious, firm decisions of stewardship make a Christian way of life.



Management According to the Apostles

If you've ever worked in any kind of organization, for-profit or not-for-profit, I'm sure you have attended a conference or two. Whatever our expectations going in, I usually find these conferences expose me to communication and problem-solving styles that are different from my own, nudging me into a little unexpected self-discovery. And it's a great opportunity to meet new people and do something different.

Here's my idea for a leadership conference: The Management Style of the Apostles. Think about it, the only thing the Apostles had more abundantly than holiness was problems. Lots and lots of problems ... most of them of the human resources variety. It's no small feat, starting Christ's Church on earth. I wouldn't want to be project manager of that endeavor.

The Acts of the Apostles is, in some ways, a big book full of problems and ways to solve them. It's a blueprint for tackling interpersonal issues in the manner of a true steward, who encounters every problem starting from the same place: What would my Master want?

It's a question we should be asking ourselves every time we, too, encounter a problem — especially problems relating to other people. What is the truth in this situation, and how would God have me communicate it? How could I handle this in a way that is worthy of the name of my Master?

In Acts, we see a lot of characteristics of everyday stewardship. We see the Apostles mindfully acknowledge the lack of peace that is posed by problems like false teachings, this Gospel's problem du jour. They prayerfully confront the obstacles to salvation posed by these issues. Always, always, always, their main objective is to reveal the will of God, remaining committed to the truth while helping newcomers find avenues to salvation.

Maybe I'm just saying it because it's my idea — but it sounds like a conference we could all use. — **Tracy Earl Welliver, MT**
