

Continuing my reflection on the US Bishops' document, Stewardship: A Disciple's Response (quotes below are from page 14). Last week we learned about the disciple's vocation, one who is called by God to be a witness of a living faith, through holiness, marriage or consecrated life, and those opportunities granted to us by God to serve God and our neighbor.

This week, we reflect on our response to the call from God. Jesus not only calls people to him but also forms them and sends them out in his service. Being sent on a mission is a consequence of being a disciple ... Jesus' call is urgent. He does not tell people to follow him at some time in the future but here and now-at this moment, in these circumstances.

here and now-at this moment, in these circumstances. So often, we live in the past or for the future, not willing to stay focused on the here and now. It is as if we are telling ourselves that, "one day I will pray more," rather than taking the moment to pray more right now as one recognizes the desire to pray. "One day I will ... work on that ... spend more time with them ... find the time ... read that ... listen to that ... respond to that call." Meanwhile, days and months and years pass living in a delusion of what might be, rather than what is.

The call to help save the soul of our neighbor is always immediate, even in situations that seem non-threatening. The recent tragedy of murder in Texas remind us that any day could become life-threatening, and more importantly soul-threatening. If you knew it was your last month, week, or day to get anything accomplished for the Lord or your family would you live differently? The radical nature of God's call to holiness and service is that it is immediate, not some day in the future. What am I doing *now to serve God, my family and the Church?*

A person can say no to God simply by neglect. A person can say no by rejecting what God is offering. A person can say no by choosing yes to something else that we know is less good. But a person can say no to Christ. Consider the wealthy and good young man who approaches Jesus asking how to lead an even better life. Sell your goods, Jesus tells him; give to the poor and follow me. "When the young man heard this statement, he went away sad, for he had many possessions" (Matthew 19:22). Attachment to possessions is always more or less a problem, both for individuals and for the community of faith... Dorothy Day recalls the 'scandal' of encountering a worldly Church–or more properly, the worldliness of some Catholics: "businesslike priests ... collective wealth... lack of sense of responsibility for the poor." She concludes: "There was plenty of charity but too little justice."

Our response to God's call is a true stewardship, a responsibility on our part to think through how blessed we are, and how we have the opportunity to bless God and others.




