



JP2 Catholic Youth Formation

We are excited about the coming year (2021-22) of Catholic Youth Formation at JP2, although we don't have all the details, yet. 

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Why were the original plans for Phase One changed? Is a school still in the plans for our parish?

A: The unexpected pause in the capital campaign due to COVID19 allowed us time to reassess the needs of the parish and take a closer look at the anticipated growth of our area so that we could determine the best use of our facilities. Our new analysis did not support the original plan. Therefore, Fr. Andrew Strobl, Pastor of St. John Paul II Parish requested permission from Archbishop Naumann to propose an alternative building plan for phase one. Archbishop Naumann gave permission for St. John Paul II Parish to submit an alternative plan for Phase One. A school will remain in the master plan for our campus.

Q: When will construction begin? How long will it take?

A: St. John Paul II Parish must have sufficient pledges to cover the total cost of construction and half of the funds collected before construction may begin. It is estimated that construction will take 18 months. This estimate is contingent on many variables including permits, availability of material and labor, and the weather, among other things.


The Memorare
