
- Protect current Kansas law, which prevents babies from being aborted up to the moment of birth.



Meetings are Tuesdays & Fridays at 7:00 p.m. in the Social Hall. The talks last about one hour. All adults and youth are invited.

















The Sacrament of First Holy Communion will be celebrated during the 11 a.m. Mass on Sunday, April 24.
