

In 2019, an activist state court radically changed the Kansas Constitution, clearing the path for nearly unlimited abortion in Kansas. Though it will not stop all abortion in Kansas, Voting YES for the Value Them Both Amendment on August 2nd:

- Will restore our Constitution to ensure there can be limits on the abortion industry that protect babies and women.
- Will protect existing commonsense restrictions
 - Parental notification for minors
 - Facility inspection, safety & sanitation standards
 - No late-term or state tax-funded abortions
- Is supported by healthcare professionals because commonsense regulations ensure women will be safer, healthier, and more protected

Since this court ruling, Kansans have seen the largest increase in the number of abortions in over 25 years, with the majority performed on out-of-state residents.

We must vote YES to ensure that Kansas does not become an abortion destination for extreme abortions in unregulated facilities.








RELIGIOUS LIFE

SINGLE LIFE

As Catholics, we believe God calls individuals to fulfill certain roles in the Church, both for their own holiness, and the good of the entire Body of Christ.

HOLINESS IS OUR COMMON GOAL

Holiness is everyone's primary vocation. Holiness means trying to be

like Jesus. It means being a "whole" person: striving for virtue, avoiding sin, and living a life of love. After the decision to follow Christ and seriously pursue holiness, your vocation is the most important decision in life.

HOLY MARRIAGE Most people are called to marriage - to wholeheartedly love their spouses and to joyfully welcome children. The purpose of marriage is for a man and woman to help each other get to heaven, and to teach their children to do the same. Like any vocation, marriage must be discerned, not assumed.

CONSECRATED LIFE Both men and women can join religious orders such as the Franciscans, Dominicans, Benedictines, etc. The life and work of religious orders varies greatly - some are primarily devoted to prayer; others work actively in schools, hospitals, orphanages, etc. Common to all religious orders are the vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience.

PRIESTHOOD Priests bring Jesus to people and people to Jesus through preaching and the sacraments. Priests are very active as they counsel people, teach classes, prepare homilies, administer parishes, and much more. Many surveys show that priests are among the happiest people in the world! Deacons, too, share in the sacrament of Holy Orders.

DEDICATED SINGLE LIFE Some people serve God as single people, without marrying or making special vows. While not a "vocation" in a strict theological sense, single people "contribute greatly to the good of the human family" (CCC 2231).

"Some live their situation in the spirit of the Beatitudes, serving God and neighbor in exemplary fashion" (CCC 1658). There are many single people who serve the Church with incredible generosity.
