Weekly Words from The Rock:

To What Depths Are We Willing To Go

People ask me all the time, "Father Schuster, who introduced you to fishing?" My father introduced me to bullhead fishing. We mostly fished Freeborn Lake, yet, on one occasion, we went to Waterville to fish the famous "Bullhead Capital." It didn't disappoint. We caught bullhead after bullhead and had a five-gallon bucket full of bullheads. That is a problem because, while it is enjoyable to catch bullheads, to have to clean them takes a considerable period of time. We wised up with time only keeping around eight bullheads per outing.

Some years, we would take a three-day vacation to Leech Lake and spent most of our time fishing for northerns. Although, one time, the wind was blowing into Battle Point and, as we drifted across the point with a jig and minnow, fish would bite but all we were left with was the head of the minnow. My father and I guessed they were walleyes thus began my fascination with fishing the Minnesota State Fish. I also give credit to Maynard, our neighbor, as he would take us to Lake Elysian from time to time and we would sometimes catch a walleye.

My father didn't have time to purchase a boat and take me fishing on a consistent basis. This was something I would have to do on my own. Over the years, I have fished out of three different boats with the most current being the one parked in St. Ann's parking lot. It took me a long time to learn the basics of walleye fishing. Even to this day, I am no expert. I would rate myself as a D-plus to C-minus walleye fisherman; however, I continue the joy of learning. I was once introduced to trolling for walleyes, and when I had the funds, purchased two trolling reels with line counters. To spool such a reel with fishing line takes a lot of fishing line. I used to change out all the line every year and that is when it happened. Someone taught me that it was unnecessary to change out all the line, it being necessary only to remove the amount of line I would need for the year. Such advice saved me a lot of line and money.

The deepest depths to which I have fished is around fifty feet. Such depths are deep for our area lakes, but nothing compared to an ocean's depth. How deep am I willing to go in my chase of the walleye? I think I have enough line on my line counter reel to plumb the depths at nine hundred feet.

In our gospel of today, we ask the question which headlines this article. To what depths is a person willing to go? We hear of two different accounts. Jairus, a synagogue official, comes forward, falls at Jesus' feet pleading with him to heal his daughter who is at the point of depth. Pause and picture the scenario for a moment. How many people do you think Jairus, an official, has had to kneel before in his life? Perhaps a government official, yet it doesn't take much speculation to answer not many.

And how about the woman who has been afflicted with hemorrhages for twelve years? She has spent all her money seeking the assistance of doctors to help with a cure all to no avail. Now wanting to make a scene before the crowd, she approaches Jesus silently touching his cloak. It works and she is healed.

Both stories are about faith. Jairus and the woman never doubted. They approached Jesus with pure faith and Jesus did the rest. If only, at times, I had as much faith. How about you?


