## PRAYER & WORSHIP

#### Weekly Words from The Rock:

#### When God Says Yes to Our Prayers

In Chapter 9 of his book, <u>Simple Steps to a Virtuous Life</u>, Father Andrew Apostoli deals with "When God Says Yes to Our Prayers." I share the content of his chapter.

I believe that God says yes to our prayers more often than not, although I don't know of any surveys that support my conclusion. When He does say yes, however, He may qualify his reply. He may say "Yes, right now," for example, or "Yes, but you will have to wait a little while," or "Yes, but you are going to have to wait a long time," or "Yes, but you will be surprised."

Let us look at these four responses. I'll illustrate the first three by comparing God answering a prayer to a person cooking a meal. Three common ways to cook are with a microwave, a stove, or a slow cooker, each of which makes a great symbol of how quickly God may respond.

Microwave cooking is nearly instantaneous: you put the food in, push a few buttons and in practically no time the food is piping hot. Sometimes God, in a manner of speaking, puts our prayer "in the microwave": We just about finish saying the prayer and He answers. I have found that God allows Saint Anthony of Padua to use the "microwave" frequently.

Once, for example, I had to make a number of important phone calls but couldn't find the paper on which I had written the phone numbers. I searched everywhere, through papers and drawers and desks, and was feeling very frustrated. Suddenly I thought, "This requires St. Anthony's help." I stopped my searching and said an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be in honor of this patron saint of finding lost things. Then, I put my hand in my pocket, and lo and behold, there was the missing piece of paper! Saint Anthony had done it again, and at microwave speed. In these cases God says, "Yes, right now" in answer to our prayers, sometimes through the intercession of saints.

Most people cook their meals on a stove, a method that takes a little time. If a pot of water boils in ten minutes, it will not boil in five; if a turkey roasts in five hours; it won't be done in two. On the stove things have to run their course. When God answers our prayers "on the stove," so to speak, He lets them run their natural course.

If a student is praying on Monday to pass an exam he will take on Thursday, his prayer will not be answered on Tuesday. If a pregnant woman is praying for a successful delivery, her prayer will not be answered until the baby in her womb has developed sufficiently. God answers such a prayer by saying, "Yes, but you will have to wait a little while," as the situation runs its course, like a good meal cooking on the stove.

Enough for this week. We will look at response three and four in our column of next week.



#### **EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL PRAYER**

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of your Son, Jesus Christ, present to us in the Most Holy Eucharist. Increase our faith so that we may always believe that You are truly present, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, in the Most Holy Eucharist, and that through partaking in this precious gift You strengthen us to live as Your disciples.

Holy Spirit, pour out on us an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Eucharist, and to worship and adore Him with our entire lives. Help us to approach the Mass and Holy Communion with greater devotion, and to make time for silent prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. Enkindle in our young people a love for the Church and the Eucharist, and raise up many holy and faithful priests who by their service at the altar will continue to nourish the people of our diocese with the Bread of Eternal Life.

#### **DECREE ON MASS STIPENDS**

The Most Holy Sacrifice of the Mass recalls the Paschal Mystery and makes it new in every celebration. Celebrating the Eucharist is the highest form of liturgy celebrated by the Church. As such, it is effective for those who take part in the offering as well as for others who are not present at the Mass.

In particular, it is the immemorial custom of the Church to ask that priests apply the celebration of each Mass for a particular intention. Intentions may be persons who are living or deceased. Intentions may also be made for a particular cause, a group of people, or for a commemoration (e.g., a wedding anniversary). Specific details of private intentions should always be made known to the priest. Pastors are also expected to offer one Mass every Sunday and holy day of obligation for the people of the parish (canon 534).

The Christian faithful themselves are encouraged to make known to priests the intention for which they wish the priest to offer the Mass. In doing so, those who are able may contribute a stipend that would be attached to the particular intention. Priests are encouraged to review canons 945-958 to ensure Mass stipends are treated appropriately and fulfilled in a timely manner.

Jesus tell us in Matthew 10:10 that "the laborer deserves his keep." The church has interpreted this statement to refer to, among others, the priests of the Church. It is fitting, therefore, that a priest receives a stipend from the Christian faithful who are able to give it, not as a payment for a sacrament, but as part of his wage for the most important work that priests do: confect the Eucharist so that the people of God may benefit.

Therefore, I hereby decree that, in accord with the decision of the bishops of the province:

#### A Mass stipend to which an intention is attached is ten (10) dollars.

This decree is effective July 1, 2024

The 2024-2025 Compensation Policy for Priests will reflect this decree. Any intentions made prior to July 1, 2024 will be honored according to the number of Masses intended with the original offering. All Mases celebrated after July 1, 2024 will be afforded the stipend at the new rate.


