## Weekly Words from The Rock:

### The Three B's

Today's gospel comes from Mark 10:46-52. I sum up the story in three B's.

- 1. The name of the person involved—Bartimaeus
- 2. His condition—Bartimaeus was blind.
- 3. The result of his condition—Bartimaeus was blind; this, the need to beg.

Imagine having to be a beggar. You rely completely, totally upon others for your very existence. Due to this reliance, it is my sense that Bartimaeus was not the quiet sort. Upon hearing someone approach, he would say, "Due to my blindness, I cannot work. Please help me." I make such an assessment because in our gospel we hear, "On hearing that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to <u>cry out</u> and say, "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me."" The very act of crying out meant Bartimaeus was outspoken in nature.

What really grabs my attention in this gospel is the response of the people to Bartimaeus' request of Jesus. Pity was the far from their minds. We hear instead, "Many rebuked him, telling him to be silent." In a frank sort of way, imagine someone telling you to "shut up" or "be quiet." Such phrases mean you are nothing but a bother and people don't want to hear from you. This can happen in many situations:

- 1. When someone doesn't agree with us politically.
- 2. When it is someone who constantly gets under our skin.
- 3. When someone disagrees with our position, and we firmly believe we are in the right.

To such, our words are the cutting of "shut up" or "be quiet" as my voice is the only voice of reason.

In response to such an attitude, I offer three alternative B's which point to our faith. They sound like this:

- 1. The <u>Beatitudes</u>. Think for a moment about the Beatitudes and ask if what I am about to say re flects the spirit of the Beatitudes. Can I be humble? A peacemaker? Merciful (thus understand ing)?
- 2. The **Being** of every person. No matter who a person is God loves them unconditionally. Every person has dignity. The being of a person, that a person has been created by God and offers a purpose in God's grand scheme, matters.
- 3. The **<u>Bringing</u>** of another to life. It boils down to one of two choices. We can either demean the dignity of another in our speech or we can build up another. Think of the amount of time Jesus spent in building up those whom society deemed "worthless."

It is my hope that the Beatitudes, Being, and Bringing be at our core as followers of Jesus Christ.





The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, or RCIA, as it has been more commonly referred to, has a name change to **ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS, OR OCIA**, per the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

The name change applies both to the process by which one enters the Church and the course/book that contains the ritual text and prayers for those steps.

In order to become a Catholic, individuals go through several rites with the final being at the Easter Vigil when they are welcomed into the Catholic Church.
