Weekly Words from The Rock: Are You Ready?

The main character of this week's gospel is John the Baptist. I have always liked John the Baptist. How many people are associated by a first name (John) and title (the Baptist)? Think about my story. How would these sound?

- A. Peter the Priest
- **B.** Peter the Fisherman
- C. Peter the Hunter
- D. Peter the Kit Kat Man
- E. Peter the Dr. Pepper Man

That isn't how things roll unless you are a John the Baptist.

John the Baptist was a unique human being. Maybe camel's hair was in vogue in his day yet not today. And your staple of food? I have shared with you some of my favorites:

- A. Pizza
- B. Spaghetti
- C. Hotdishes
- D. Soups (in the winter months)

Still, I came from a farm family where there was nothing fancy. It was mainly meat, veggies, and potatoes. For John the Baptist? Honey and locusts.

I have often wondered what type of child John the Baptist was while growing up. He may have been a handful. Think about what he says in the pages of Scripture,

- To the crowds who came out to be baptized by him, "You brood of vipers! Who warned you of the coming wrath" (Luke 3:7).
- Appearing in Judea, his words weren't words of greeting. He began his preaching with the words, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Matthew 3:2).
- He challenged King Herod, and it cost him his life (see Mark 6:17-29).

And that leads us to our heading of today, are you ready? Are you ready for the challenge of John the Baptist? Fresh off his words from Luke 3:7, the people ask, what are we to do? Here is his response:

- 1. To the crowds, "If you have two tunics share with the person who has none. And whoever has food should do likewise" (Luke 3:11).
- 2. To the tax collectors, "Stop collecting more than what is prescribed" (Luke 3:13).
- 3. To the soldiers, "Do not practice extortion, do not falsely accuse anyone, and be satisfied with your wages" (Luke 3:14).

These responses lead to our challenge. What might John the Baptist state if we asked, "What are we to do?" I can't really answer because every person is unique, still I am certain he would have something to say. There is a challenge he would have for each of us. Such is the call of Advent. As we prepare for the Christmas story, we are to repent, to repent of whatever stumbling blocks stand in the way of our readying for the coming of our Savior. May we repent! May we be found ready!



EUCHARISTIC RIVIAL NEWS: THE YEAR OF MISSION

Lets back up to 2023, the Eucharistic Congress in Mankato, June 10th, 2023. Actually the Eucharistic Revival resulted in Eucharistic Congresses taking place all over the US. The Movement was spearheaded from the result of a 2019 pew study which indicated what may had long suspected; that few Catholics, approximately 30 percent, fully believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This grassroots movement, the Revival, called for by the bishops of the U.S., is rekindling a living faith in the hearts of Catholics across America. If you didn't attend the Congress in Mankato, you can watch a video of it on the Diocese of Winona-Rochester webpage. Go to click ABOUT click EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL dowr.org Scroll down 3/4 down the page. Its incredible. You may see someone you know. Following the Congress, a Parish Team may have been started in your parish. It is the goal that the Parish Team or any individual acting alone or in a group, continue the momentum of the Congress. Start by listening to Bishop Barron's Congress' keynote speech. This is something the Parish Teams had been asked about providing and it is now available. Enjoy watching it independently or get a group together.


