The Rules

Not content to stop there, I also came across a poster entitled "7 Rules of Life." What do you think of these?


ADORATION AND CONFESSION will be offered on each FIRST SUNDAY of the month. The next adoration is, MARCH 2ND from 11:00-12:00.


