Weekly Words from The Rock:

Four Weeks In And...

We are back to the Sundays of Ordinary Time. With the conclusion of the Easter season, we picked up with the Tenth Week in Ordinary Time. However, the Sundays since Pentecost have honored Feasts and Solemnities. In order, they are:

- 1. The Most Holy Trinity. Three persons in one God whom we worship as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Corpus Christi. In the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, we receive Jesus Christ. The Eucharist is not a sign or symbol of Jesus Christ rather his very presence, real presence.
- 3. Saints Peter and Paul. June 29th commemorates the mission of the universal church. Saint Peter was the apostle to the Jewish people. Saint Paul was the apostle to the Gentile people. The Jewish people and Gentile people marked the entirety of the whole world in the first century.

And finally, this weekend we come to a Sunday which celebrates Ordinary Time - the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Please remember what I have shared previously. When we think of the word "ordinary" words which come to mind are:

Unexceptional

Normal

Routine

Such isn't the case of the Church's understanding of Ordinary Time. Ordinary Time marks the longest season of the church year and is filled with stories of Jesus' healing, teaching, preaching, and ministering. It is a time which challenges us on how we are to live our faith, how we are to act, what we are to say, and how to be true disciples. Without Ordinary Time, we struggle to understand who we are and why we exist.

Thus, in the week's ahead, pay attention to the readings. Learn from Jesus Christ and pray we conform our lives more to that of our Savior.

Possible To Be A Christian Without Church?

This comes from the Wesleyan Christian Advocate. Question: Can I be a Christian without joining the church? Answer: Yes, it is possible. It is something like being:

- A student who will not go to school.
- A citizen who does not pay taxes or vote.


ADORATION AND CONFESSION will be offered on the 2nd SATURDAY JULY 12th from 4:00-4:45.


