Weekly Words from The Rock:

I Need To Be...

I am the type of person who needs to be doing something. I have always been this way. In our gospel, we hear the story of Martha and Mary. It is fair to ask, "Father, are you more of a Martha or a Mary?" From what I have posed, my makeup is more on the side of Martha.

Let me give you an example. When I was a child, I remember always being busy. Here are some things I recall: A. Helping my father with chores or work in the field.

- B. Helping my mother if she needed something from the freezer or pantry.
- C. Throwing a tennis ball against the garage door working on my velocity and location as a pitcher.
- D. Fishing bullheads on Freeborn Lake.
- E. Building a fort in the grove.
- F. Playing in the sandbox.
- G. Riding bicycle.

They were great times. When it comes to the story of Martha and Mary, we learn the importance of time "doing" things and time "praying" things. Despite my makeup, I have come to learn the importance of sitting at the feet of Jesus in prayer. It is important to pray. Prayer grounds us and better guides us throughout the course of a day. Will prayer change my makeup? I doubt it. I will always be a "busy" personality. But a day without prayer finds one with the mindset of Martha, one is way too anxious and worried about many things. Find time to pray!

If one ties himself down to making payments of \$50 each week for some time on items for personal enjoyment, he pays willingly. But if that same person placed that much in the collection plate each week., many people would say he is crazy.

What has happened? It is a crazy world indeed, where first things come last and last things come first!
