## Weekly Words from The Rock:

### How Things Have Changed

Some people clamor for the "good old days." We hear things like:

- A. Things were better in the "good old days."
- B. The Church was better off in the "good old days."
- C. Life was simpler in the "good old days."

To completely disavow such thinking seems rash; however, let us not forget the advances we have made. I will give an example. A critical factor in the development of teaching as a profession has been the growth of professional organizations for teachers. Although today's working conditions still need improvement, they sharply contrast with the restrictions teachers once endured. Here are the details of what is reputed to be a Wisconsin teacher's contract in 1922, calling for a salary of \$75 a month.

- A. Not to get married. The contract becomes null and void immediately if the teacher marries.
- B. Not to keep company with men.
- C. To be home between the hours of 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. unless in attendance at a school function.
- D. Not to loiter in downtown ice-cream parlors.
- E. Not to leave town at any time without the permission of the chairman of Trustees.
- F. Not to smoke cigarettes.
- G. Not to drink beer, wine, or whiskey.
- H. Not to ride in a carriage or automobile with any man except her brother or father.
- I. Not to dress in bright colors.
- J. Not to dye her hair.
- K. Not to wear less than two petticoats.
- L. To keep the schoolroom clean:
  - 1. To sweep the classroom floor at least one daily.
  - 2. To scrub the classroom at least once daily.
  - 3. To clean the blackboard at least once daily
  - 4. To start the fire at 7:00 a.m. so that the room will be warm by 8:00 a.m. when the children arrive.
- M. Not to wear dress shorter than two inches above the ankles.
- N. Not to wear face powder, mascara, or to paint the lips.

Miss (name of teacher) agrees:

How things have changed. While the past can seem rosy, remember what the old adage says: Be careful what you wish for. Our Lord doesn't wish us to live in the past. While lessons of the past are lessons to be learned, our Lord put us here (in the now) to paint the portrait of the here and now and push ahead to the future. St. Paul reminds us in his letter to the Philippians 3:13, "Just one thing: forgetting what lies behind but straining forward to what lies ahead." Always remember, change what you can change, live when God has called you to live, and fight the good fight with and by the grace of God.

### One Other Thought...

Here is a free piece of advice which could be given in any century or period of time. While I have caught many fish, I have never mounted a fish. Yet, every mounted fish I have observed hanging on someone's wall shares one characteristic: You never see a fish on the wall with its mouth shut.

How was the fish caught? It opened its mouth. How did the fish end up in the livewell? It opened its mouth. Do you see a common thread with humans? Think of how little trouble we would find ourselves in if we did just one thing. **Keep our mouth shut!**

### BREWSTER

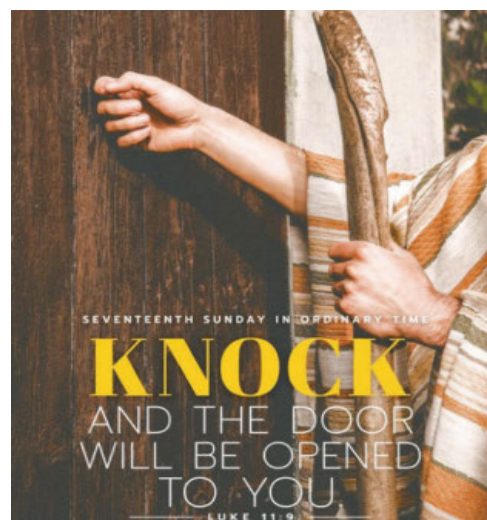

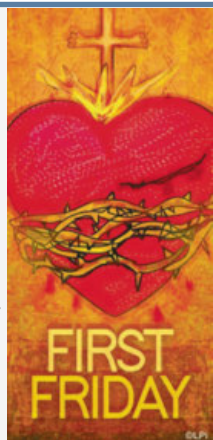
