# PRAYER & WORSHIP

## Weekly Words from The Rock:

### Prayer

Prayer is vital to our lives, so I want to reiterate some points I made in my homily on prayer. First, how come God sometimes doesn't answer my prayers? When we pray the Lord's prayer, we call God our Father. A father, like a mother, has insight. To a request, a father may say, "yes." But in wisdom, he may also respond, "No, not yet or I don't think this is a good idea." Why? For our own good. If our earthly father has such insight, our heavenly Father has far greater insight. Seeing the big picture, God sees beyond time. God sees our entire story. In wisdom, He wants what is best for us. That means God to our prayer may respond, "yes," "no," "not yet," or "this is not a wise idea."

Second, does prayer make a difference? Here is the story I shared:

How much does a prayer weigh? There is a story of a grocery store owner who tried to weigh one. A tired looking woman came into the store and asked for enough food to make a dinner for her children. The grocer asked her how much she could spend. The frail looking woman answered, "I have nothing to offer but a little prayer." The storekeeper was not very sentimental nor religious, so he said, "Write it on paper and I will weigh it." So she did. The grocer placed the prayer on the weight side of the old-fashioned scales. Then he began piling food on the other side; but to his amazement, the scale would not go down. He finally became flustered and gave the woman a large bag of food. The grocer never saw the woman again, but he treasures the slip of paper upon which the woman's prayer had been written – "Please, Lord, give us this day our daily bread."

As I noted in my homily, if we really knew how much our prayer mattered, we would destroy it with our pride. It is best we do not know the impact of each, individual prayer; otherwise, we might think we were God. Trust God and trust He always does something with our prayer.

Third, what about distractions in prayer? Distractions are a normal part of being human. One of the ways the devil leads us away from God is to discourage us. It sounds like this, "Ah, you're just going to get distracted so why pray? Prayer doesn't work, you're wasting your time, it's boring, you have too many other things to do which are more exciting." When this happens, it is best we pray, and in our prayer should we become distracted ask, "Is this something I should be offering to God?" If it is, offer it to God. Pray for God's assistance. If it isn't, ask God to help you let it go and let it go.

And finally, when God answers our prayer, be grateful. Here is the story I shared:

St. Peter was giving a tour of the facilities to a new arrival in heaven. They paused at one large room filled with hundreds of busy angels. "This is the Receiving Section," St. Peter shouted above the noisy activity. "All prayer petitions to God come in here for recording and processing."

They moved on to the next large room. "This is Packaging and Delivery," Peter explained. "Here is where the requested graces and blessings are packaged and delivered back to those on earth." The new arrival was awed at the immense operation.

Then they passed a small office. Inside there was one bored-looking angel sitting behind an empty desk. "What's that?" The new arrival asked. St. Peter said, "Oh, this is the Acknowledgement Station. There's really very little to do here. After people receive the blessings they prayed for, very few bother to send in acknowledgements. But, if they do, we record that in here."

"How does one acknowledge God's blessings?" the newcomer asked. "Simple," Peter said. "Just saying the Lord's Prayer would do it."

The story reminds us that when we have a prayer answered to acknowledge it. There isn't anything we have or have been given that doesn't come from God. God gives; we receive. Be thankful!

With all this in mind, never become discouraged. Just pray!

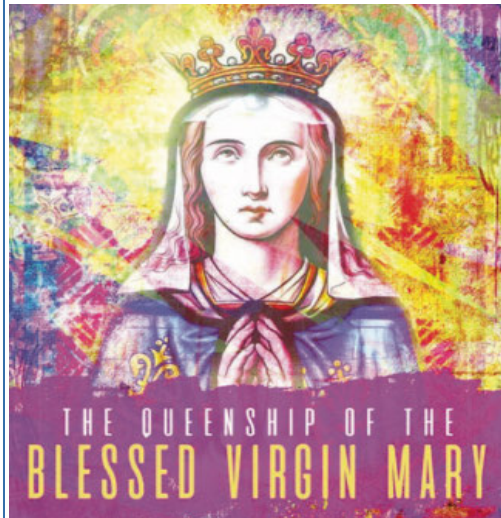
