Dr. Pepper Per Gallon...

This is something outside the realm of faith; however, I like to include items in this column to help us keep things in their proper perspective. We know that unleaded fuel is around \$3.00 per gallon, and it is easy to grumble about the cost. However, let us do a comparison with other items and their cost per gallon (the current day prices of items may be higher however I am using the figures from an article I read).

1. A 16-ounce bottle of Diet Snapple is \$1.29. That would equate to \$10.32 per gallon.
2. A 16-ounce bottle of Lipton Iced Tea is \$1.19. That would equate to \$9.52 per gallon.
3. A 20-ounce bottle of Gatorade is \$1.59. That would equate to \$10.17 per gallon.
4. A 16-ounce bottle of Ocean Spray is \$1.25. That would equate to \$10.00 per gallon.
5. A 12-ounce bottle of brake fluid is \$3.15. That would equate to \$33.60 per gallon.
6. A 6-ounce bottle of Vick's Nyquil is \$8.35. That would equate to \$178.13 per gallon.
7. A 4-ounce bottle Pepto Bismol is \$3.85. That would equate to \$123.20 per gallon.
8. A 7-ounce bottle of whiteout is \$1.39. That would equate to \$25.42 per gallon.
9. A 1.5-ounce bottle of Scope mouthwash is \$0.99. That would equate to \$84.48 per gallon.
10. A 9-ounce bottle of Evian water is \$1.49. That would be \$21.19 per gallon.
11. Someone calculated the cost of computer ink at \$5,200 per gallon.

These prices really capture your attention. What wasn't included was my favorite soda. If I pay \$2.69 for a 20-ounce bottle of Dr. Pepper, that equates to \$17.21. The next time you are filling your tank with \$3.00 fuel and start to grumble take some time to pause and think. I will be glad I'm not filling my tank on Dr. Pepper.

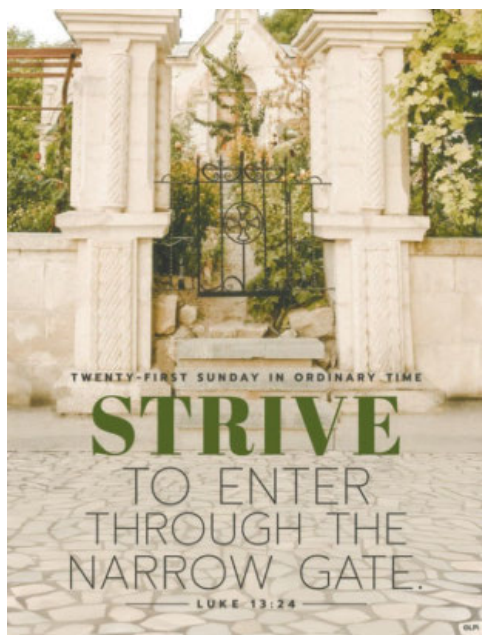
