PRAYER & WORSHIP

Weekly Words from The Rock:

Being Humble!

Our gospel pericope of this Sunday comes from the fourteenth chapter of Luke's gospel. In verses seven through fourteen, placed before us is the story of one being invited to a banquet. When invited we are told to seat ourselves at the lowest place so that when the host comes, we may be invited to a higher position of honor. We are also warned of the opposite happening. Initially taking a place of honor, we may be asked to give our place to another. Verse 11 summarizes by saying, "For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but whoever humbles himself will be exalted."

There was a song by Mac Brown composed in 1974 entitled "It's Hard to Be Humble." The first verses have the following lyrics:

"Oh Lord, it's hard to be humble
When you are perfect in every way
I can't wait to look in the mirror
Cause I get better lookin' each day
To know me is to love me
I must be a h--- of a man
Oh Lord, it's hard to be humble
But I'm doing the best I can.

I used to have a girlfriend
But I guess she just couldn't compete
With all of these love-starved women
Who keep clamoring at my feet
Well I could probably find me another
But I guess they're all in awe of me
Who cares? I never get lonesome
Cause I treasure my own company.

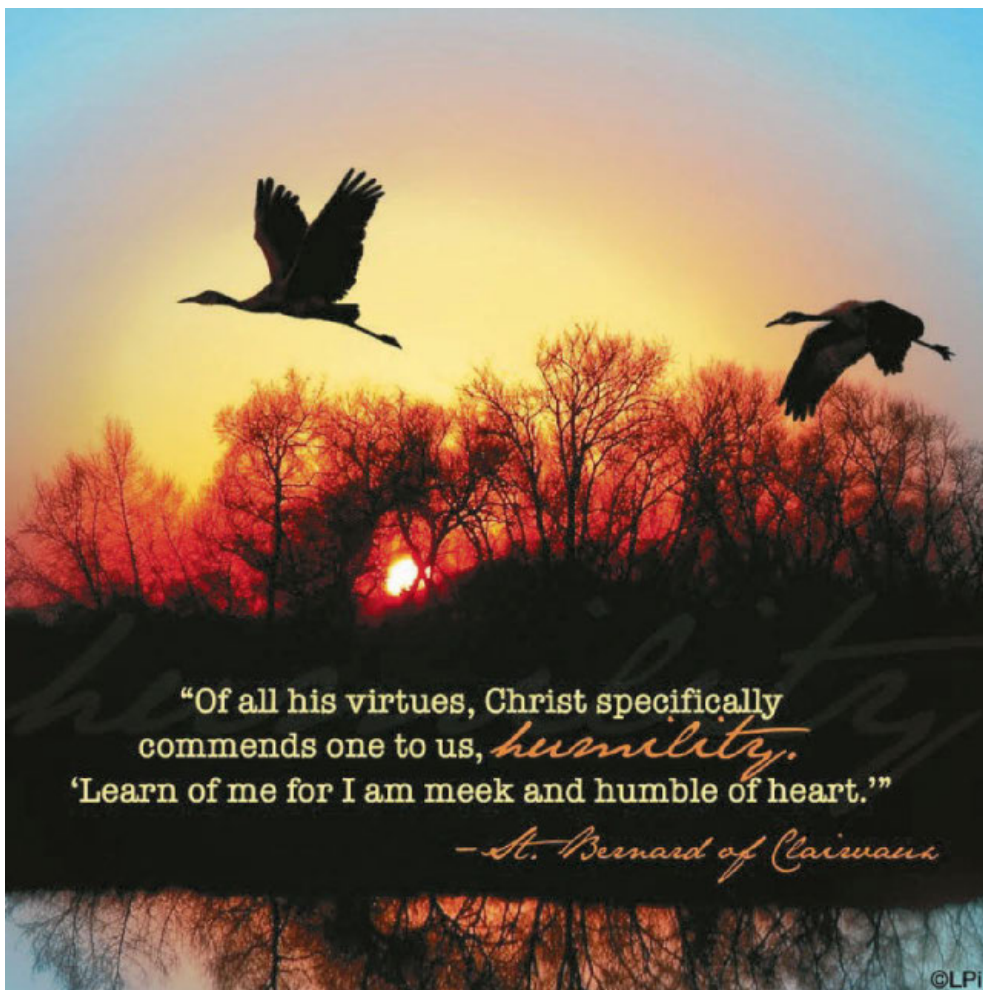
Oh Lord, it's hard to be humble

If you listen to the song, it is somewhat catchy; although, I must admit that someone has a rather inflated sense of themselves. To such, a dose of humility wouldn't be a bad thing. I've never had such an over-inflated sense of myself but from time to time, I forget to stay "humbly grounded." Here is one such story. At a former assignment, it was the Easter season and I was doing the Sprinkling Rite. I was having fun with the people giving some of the congregation a double or triple shot of holy water. I was almost finished when I came to the last couple of pews. Wanting to give the people a "triple dose," as I was sprinkling, the aspergillum flew out of my hand, landed against the back of a pew, made a loud crashing sound, and left a mark in the pew. Luckily, the aspergillum didn't hit a soul.

As I retrieved the aspergillum, my face turned red in embarrassment. I had gotten ahead of myself, and a dose of humility was the order of the day. Fortunately, such an incident has never again occurred. Remember, stay grounded and be humble!

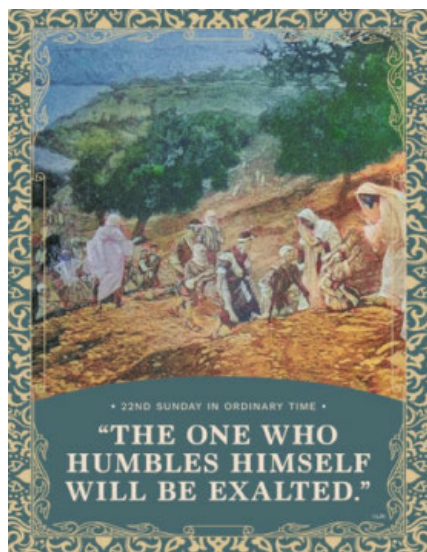

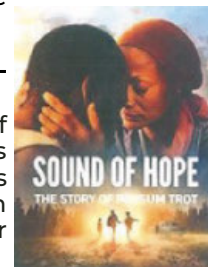

OCIA PROGRAM


