Weekly Words from The Rock:

Calculate!

In last week's column, we spoke of humility. I shared a story of being humbled and to live life means we are all humbled at some point. This week's gospel reminds of another way a person can be humbled. Jesus states, "Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion? Otherwise, after laying the foundation and finding himself unable to finish the work the onlookers should laugh at him and say, 'This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish.' Or what king marching into battle would not first sit down and decide whether with ten thousand troops he can successfully oppose another king advancing upon him with twenty thousand troops? But if not, while he is still far away, he will send a delegation to ask for peace terms" (Luke 14:28-32).

The gospel's thrust is discipleship. Does one realize the cost of discipleship? One must sit down and calculate. Am I willing to put God first in my life? Am I willing to renounce my possessions for the sake of the kingdom of heaven? Am I willing to put God before father, mother, wife, children, brothers, sisters, friends? If anything stands in the way of Jesus, one cannot be a true, committed disciple.

Speaking of calculating, for three summers I worked as a carpenter. I cut many 2 by 4's over those summer months. The one lesson learned was to make certain the measurement was correct. It is one thing to cut a board too long; however, cut it too short and you are doomed. You cannot add to a board. One would be openly mocked when a 2 by 4 was tossed to another only to learn it was short by four inches.

Jesus wants us to calculate carefully. Is being a disciple something we truly desire? If so, then deny yourself, take up your cross and follow Jesus Christ!

"Lean Not On Your Own Understanding"

A college student was in a philosophy class. There was a class discussion about whether or not God existed. The professor had the following logic: "Has anyone in this class heard God?" Nobody spoke. "Has anyone in this class touched God?" Nobody spoke. "Has anyone in this class seen God?" When nobody spoke for the third time, he simply stated, "Then there is no God."

One student didn't like the sound of this at all and asked for permission to speak. The professor granted it, and the student stood up and asked the following questions of his classmates: "Has anyone in this class heard our professor's brain?" Silence. "Has anyone in this class touched our professor's brain?" Absolute silence. "Has anyone in this class seen our professor's brain?" When nobody in the class dared to speak, the student concluded, "Then, according to our professor's logic, it must be true that our professor has no brain!"

The student received an "A" in the class. It only goes to show that you cannot always lean on your own understanding!

An Important Lesson: Everyone Matters!

Someone shared this story. During my second month of college our professor gave us a pop quiz. I was a conscientious student and had breezed through the questions, until I read the last one. It read, "What is the first name of the woman who cleans the school?" Surely this was some kind of joke. I had seen the cleaning woman several times. She was tall, dark and in her fifties but how would I know her name? I handed in my paper, leaving the last question blank.

Just before class ended, one student asked if the last question would count toward our quiz grade. "Absolutely," said the professor. "In your careers, you will meet many people. All are significant. They deserve your attention and care even if all you do is smile and say 'hello.'"

With that remark, I have a hunch they all learned the name of the cleaning woman.
