Weekly Word from the Rock:

Exaltation of the Holy Cross

As we come to worship this weekend, our weekend celebration is not the Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time rather the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Let us remember the colors worn with the appropriate season:

- Advent (Violet)
- Christmas (White)
- Ordinary Time (Green)
- Lent (Violet)

Easter (White)

As you notice, none of those colors are associated with this weekend's Feast. Our color of this weekend is red.

Red is worn to honor:

The Holy Spirit.

Martyrs who died for the faith.

The blood of Jesus Christ.

Specifically red, worn to recall the blood of Jesus Christ, is worn on Palm Sunday, Good Friday, and the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (September 14).

Our gospel passage contains one of the most famous Scripture passages in the Bible. Our passage is John 3:13-17. John 3:14-15 reads, "And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." In the twenty-first chapter of Numbers, we hear the story of Moses and the serpent. As the people continue their journey from Egypt to the Promised Land, they grumble about the lack of food and water. Due to their complaints, the Lord sends seraph serpents which bite the people, causing many to die. Realizing their sin, they turn to Moses repentant. Moses places a serpent on a pole and anyone who looks at it is healed. The same promise is made of Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ died on the cross due to sin, yet, in dying on the cross, he also saved people from their sins. That is why the word gospel means "Good News." The Good News is Jesus Christ has conquered all.

The author of this "Good News" is God the Father. In John 3:16-17, we read, "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him." The passage teaches:

God the Father recognized the power of sin.

God the Father realized the only way sin was to be overcome was through his Son.

God sent his Son into this world.

God sent his Son not to condemn the world.

God sent his Son to save the world.

Hopefully, we understand why love is the defining word of God the Father. God loves us and will do everything for us to enter his love for eternity.

The cross is a marvel to me.

The wood of the cross reminds of where sin entered the world. The tree of the forbidden fruit.

That somehow, we could be so cruel as to crucify our Savior.

The cross powers its way to heaven (the vertical beam) and across all peoples and the world (the vertical beam).

As nails adhere the hands and feet of Jesus, the resurrection adheres to all of us.

From the lance thrust in his side, signifying his death, God creates. The blood and water mark the sacraments of baptism and the Eucharist.

Is it any wonder that we exalt the cross today? From something so cruel, our salvation is found. Blessed be the cross of Jesus Christ!






