Weekly Words from The Rock:

And Just Like That...

And just like that, we are back in Ordinary Time. The first two Sundays of our venture back into Ordinary Time celebrate two feasts:

- The Holy Trinity
- Corpus Christi – The Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Savior.

While Sundays mark Holy Trinity and Corpus Christi, the weekdays define themselves by Ordinary Time.

On this Sunday of Ordinary Time, I have been reflecting on the recent graduates. The days take me back to when I was in school. Around this time of the year, our school year wrapped up, and summer vacation was upon us. Venturing back into my primary years of school, some memories come to mind surrounding summer vacation:

- Riding a bike around the yard and up and down the driveway. I eventually became daring enough to make a bike ramp, and pedaling as hard as I could, flying through the air.
- Walking beans or riding beans (on a bean bar).
- Bullhead fishing (more on that in a moment).
- Spearing carp in our drainage ditch while my father planted corn or beans.
- Trapping pocket gophers.
- Going on a picnic as a family.
- Getting an ice cream cone at A&W Root Beer, only for all of us children to be told by our father, “Hurry up and eat it. I don’t want ice cream dripping on the seats of the car.”
- Taking a hoe and dropping it into the ground like a cultivator and walking up and down the corn rows.
- Helping with the chores.
- Mowing the lawn.

Before we move ahead, let us go back to bullhead fishing. My father, one of my sisters, and I were bullhead fishing at Manley Bakken. He had a nice sand beach, a great location to fish. I was minding my own business when my father cast his fishing line. The hook didn’t make it to the water, finding its way into my cheek. That really hurt and my father apologized profusely. In the end, no harm was done, the hook removed, and we drove home with bullheads in a five-gallon bucket.

With my graduation, things were different. Some of what I mentioned above remained part of the routine. What changed was college was now on the horizon. I would no longer walk the halls of Freeborn High School for my studies. With college and its expense, some things had to give. Post-high school education was not cheap. The following joined the routine:

- A summer job.
- Raising soybeans.
- Raising hogs.

This didn’t mean that each brought in income for college expenses. One summer I raised a group of forty hogs, and several died because of a disease. That meant a losing proposition.

To be where I currently am, it took all the above to unfold. Summer after summer after summer. Ordinary Time is no different. It brings with it the following:

1. The stories of Jesus’ healing.
2. The stories of Jesus’ teaching.
3. The stories of Jesus’ preaching.

Ordinary Time after Ordinary Time, year after year, we hear the same stories to help mold and shape us. They bring us to where we are in our lives. Take the stories seriously. Grow in your faith. And remember, Jesus Christ journeys with you!

QUINCEANERA

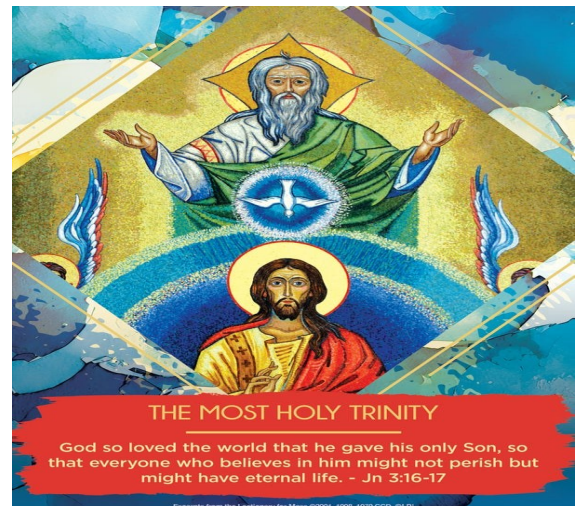
"Is there a Quinceanera in your near future? This is a reminder that we need at least three (3) months notice for this celebration. For more details and requirements, please contact the office.

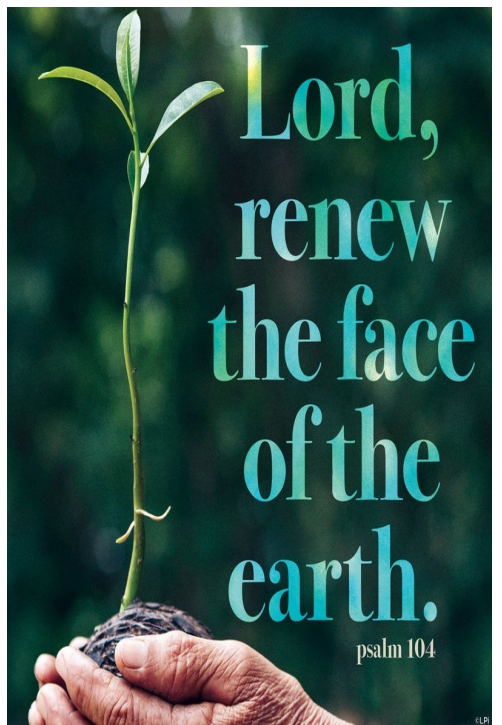

When Nick arrived at our Rochester Overnight Shelter, he was homeless, struggling with addiction, and had ridden his bike all the way from the Twin Cities. We helped him to get connected with AA supports, find temporary work, and obtain work clothes. Our shelter staff also packed him a lunch and some snacks each night to get him through the following workday. Eventually, this led to full-time employment and an apartment of his own. After months of hearing nothing from Nick, he returned recently with a few cases of water to check in on our shelter guests. He was so thankful that Catholic Charities was there for him when he was ready to give up hope!

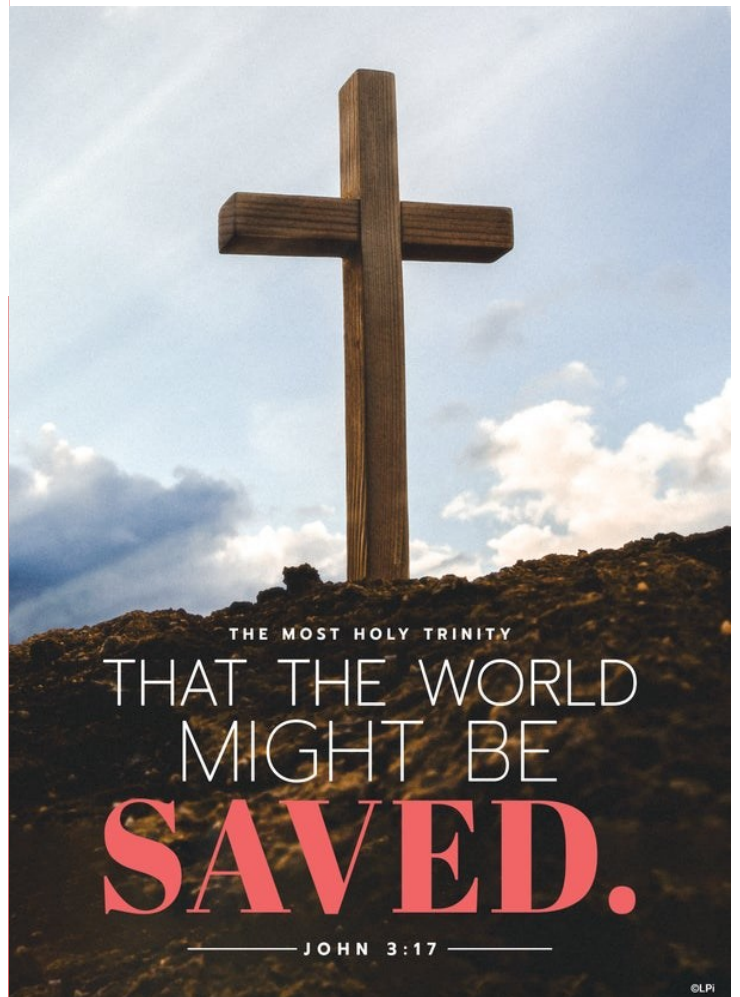
