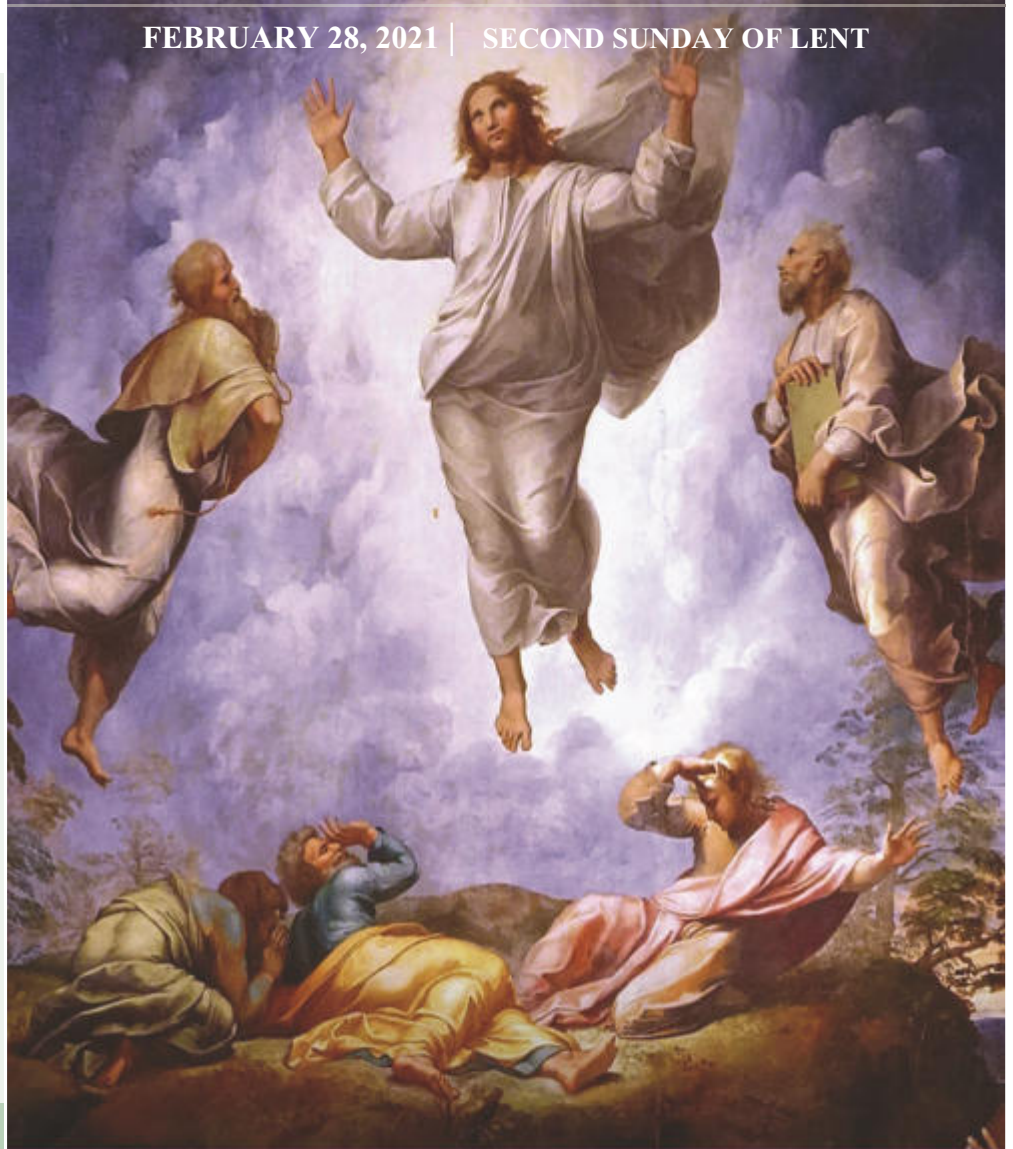

THE LENTEN FASTING AND ABSTINENCE REQUIREMENTS:

Good Friday is an obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics.

In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are obligatory for members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards and the norms on fasting from age 18 until age 59.



Reflections from Fr. Brendan:

How could Moses be a follower Jesus? Moses lived somewhere between 1,300 to 1,500 years before Christ. He leads God's People out of Egypt, through the desert to a place outside the Promised Land where he spends his final day on earth (Deuteronomy 34:1-7). As he looks West, God tells him, "This is the land of which I swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, saying, 'I will give it to your descendants'; I have let you see it with your eyes, but you shall not cross over there." Moses is buried somewhere around Mount Nebo (You can search it on Google Maps.). He is not permitted to cross into the Promised Land until today, the day of Christ's transfiguration (Mark 9:2-10), where he appears with Elijah inside the Promised Land, standing at the feet of Jesus. Sometimes we also have to wait to see why certain things happen in our life. It may be that God will only explain those small miracles, the circumstances that affected us, the sufferings we offered up... after we cross from this life to the other and stand before Jesus. If we follow God in this life, we too can stand at the feet of Jesus in the next life.


