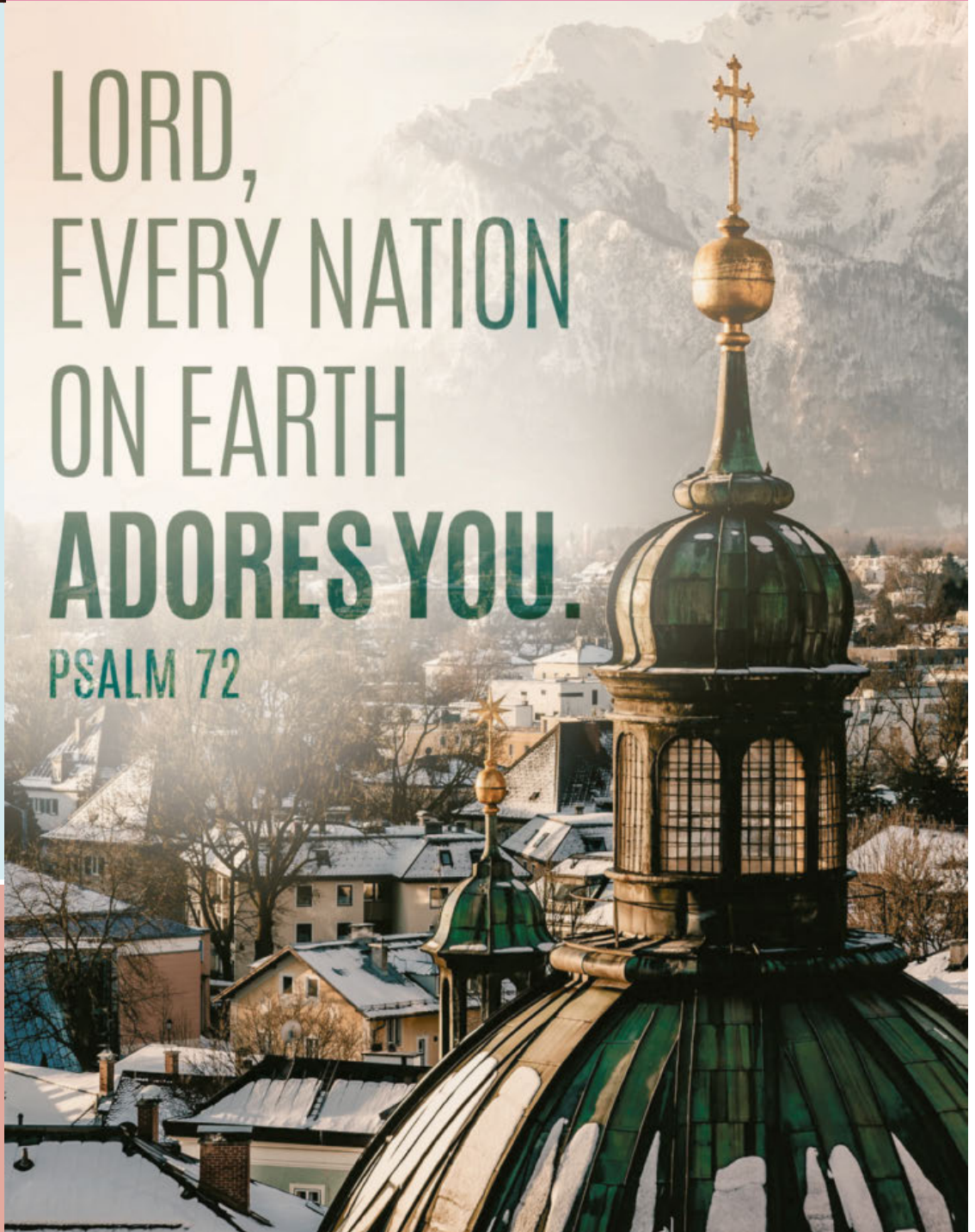

Reflection from Father Brendan:

Loyalty points. Businesses offer lots of them at Christmas. They motivate customers to return by 1) offering discounts, and, 2) giving more access to services. The Three Kings respond with gratitude to Jesus for the blessings and loyalty God offers each human being. Born in the prison of sin, Jesus Christ, discounts it (Eliminates its authority in our lives.) and gives us access to freedom. Born as orphans, God formally adopts you at baptism which makes you his son or daughter. Born as physical creatures, God gives humans access to heaven by becoming human. Therefore, the Three Kings are “*overjoyed at seeing the star,*” “*did him homage,*” and “*offered him gifts*” (Matthew 2:12). Having a living relationship with Christ is your grateful response to God’s loyalty.

DO YOU HAVE 3 MINUTES A DAY? WE NEED YOU!!! Do you wish to share in the power of prayer or need a mass said for you or your intentions?? We have 7 Roses. A Rose is made up of 15 persons praying their decade (10 Hail Mary’s) of the Rosary every day for a year. Each person is assigned which decade they shall pray for the year. A votive candle is lit for Living members on the Feast Days of Assumption & Immaculate Conception. It is possible you can say your decade in 3 minutes. There are openings in many of the Roses. Dues are \$2.00 a year. You do not need to be a member of any particular parish – we just need you to prayer with us. 
