

Reflection from Father Brendan:

Surgery can restore health to a joint or organ, but the incisions leave a mark. The same is true of baptism. Born a slave to sin, each soul can turn to Jesus Christ for healing. This is why Catholics pray, "I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins" (Nicene Creed). Like surgery, baptism leaves an eternal mark so powerful it can only be done once. It "cannot be repeated" (Canon Law 845). When Christ receives baptism in Luke 3:15-22, he divinely institutes it as the first sacrament of initiation. Canon Law, paragraph 840, states, "The sacraments of the New Testament were instituted by Christ the Lord and entrusted to the Church." Baptism is necessary to "validly be admitted to the other sacraments" (Canon Law 842). It therefore gives us added access to graces and blessings as adopted sons and daughters of the living God.
