PASTOR'S NOTES...Fr. Ron Huberty

On this Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, we hear from prophet Isaiah reminding us that God delights in us. Hearing this good news should move us to share our faith and how God is blessing us day after day. The miracle by Jesus at the wedding in Cana, Jesus' first miracle in John's Gospel, reminds us that wine in the Bible was a symbol of joy. Eternal life will be a heavenly banquet, the Eucharist, where wine is changed into the Blood of Christ. The miracle at Cana happens in our midst as Jesus prepares us for the heavenly banquet. Mary's participation in that first miracle should fill us with joy to know she is praying on our behalf that we will always do what Jesus asks of us in living our faith in order that we will one day share at the banquet table of everlasting joy in heaven.

We postponed the First Reconciliation last Saturday and have it scheduled for March 12. I ask everyone to be understanding as we work through the remainder of the Religious Education schedule in our parishes especially in light of the ongoing Covid-19 situation.

This week, January 18-25, marks a week of prayer for Christian Unity. This year's theme takes us back to Epiphany Sunday, *"We saw the star in the East and we came to worship him."* (Matthew 2:2) This theme was chosen by the Middle East Council of Churches. From the World Council of Churches, it states: *"More than ever, in these difficult times, we need a light that shines in the darkness and that light, Christians proclaim, has been manifested in Jesus Christ."* May the light of Christ unite us in prayer and witness of faith in order to be the light of Christ shining in our world especially next Saturday when we are asked to pray for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children.
