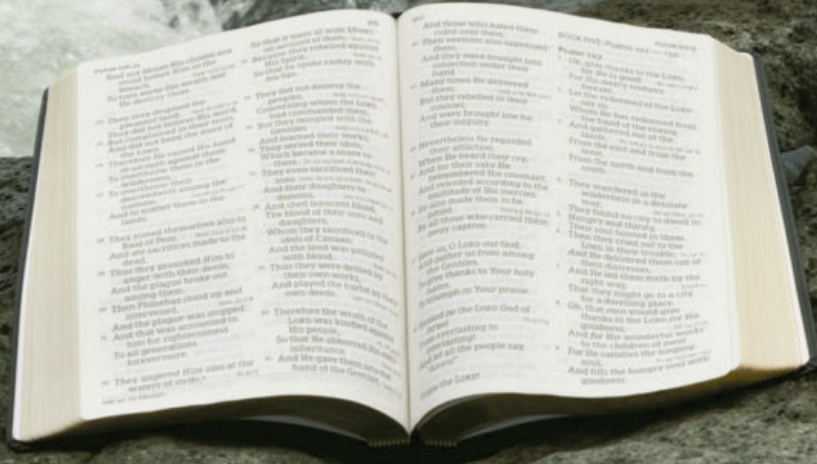

Confirmation: We will have two Confirmation Masses in our Christ the King Area Faith Community on Sunday, February 27. The first will be in Wilno at 10:00 AM for students from St Dionysius, St Genevieve, Ss Peter & Paul and St John Cantius. The second will be in Canby at 1:30 PM for students from St Leo and St Peter. Please pray for the students as they prepare to receive this Sacrament of Initiation and enter fully into the Church.

Reflection from Father Brendan:

People sometimes call the Mass, Catholic calisthenics. Yes, but where does the Bible show us different body postures related to prayer? One example is from Nehemiah 8:2-10. *"Ezra the scribe stood on a wooden platform... opened the scroll so that all the people might see it."* The people *"bowed"* and *"prostrated themselves before the Lord."* At Mass we pray like Ezra and Jesus (in Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21); by standing when something important, like the Gospel, is spoken or prayed. We sit to listen, like students and a teacher, and disciples with their rabbi. We bow when we pass by something sacred; servers carrying candles make a small bow to the Eucharist during the procession. People genuflect when entering and leaving the presence of God, Jesus in the tabernacle. This is most common when we enter or exit a church for Mass. We also kneel at the Eucharistic consecration, the moment God enters your presence and turns bread into his Body and Blood. At priesthood ordination a man will prostrate, extend his entire body on the floor, as a sign that he dies to self and offers his life to Christ. For this reason, a priest will also prostrate during Good Friday services. Corinthians 12:12-30 reminds us God *"constructed the body."* The English word, calisthenics, comes from two Greek words, *kállos (κάλλος)*, meaning *"beauty,"* and *sthenos (σθένος)*, meaning *"strength."* At Mass we pray, even with our bodies. May your prayer honor your God with beauty and strength.

(Wilno) It was brought to the attention of the Wilno Cemetery Committee that there are 3 soldiers who were killed in action that just have a Veteran's Administration footstone marking their graves. We would like to provide a headstone similar to those marking the graves at our National Cemeteries to honor these fallen hero's. We have contacted the families of these hero's & they are in support of this effort. An approximate cost would be in the \$7000.00 range for stones for the three graves. We have commitments to fund a share of this already, but need more funds to move forward. If you are willing to donate, please make a check out to the St. John Cantius Cemetery Fund & mark it for KIA Tombstones. The 3 soldiers that gave their all are Roy Przymus, Daniel Herchowski & Paul Jerzak. Any questions, please contact Elliot Sovell or Bill Jerzak. Thank You!


