Reflections from Fr. Brendan.... St. Mother Teresa and her sisters are famous for serving the poor. When some sisters suggested they reduce their prayer time to have more time for work she surprised them by adding an hour of prayer. Sirach 3:17-29 says “humble yourself...and you will find favor with God.” When Mother Teresa and her sisters humbled themselves by adding an hour of prayer to each day, she noticed a change and said, “Our love for Jesus becomes more intimate, our love for each other more understanding, and our love for the poor more compassionate.” Still people naturally focus on their social status. College students who do this are called “campus climbers.” They are so busy climbing over and past each other that they fear one another and eventually get in the way of their own success. Jesus shines light on the “campus climbers” in Luke 14:7-14 saying they choose “places of honor at the table.” Instead of this he says, “take the lowest place,” meaning voluntarily ground yourself so God can bless you in unexpected ways. Stay humble. Mother Teresa lived, served, and died in Fr. Beschi’s home country of India. We wish him health and safety on his trip back home during September.

Bishop Zielinski has announced the following assignments for the Christ the King Area Faith Community, effective October 1, 2025, at Noon:

Fr. Beschi Savarimuthu will serve as Parochial Administrator of St. Leo in St. Leo and St. Peter in Canby, residing at the rectory at St. Peter's in Canby. For the months of October through December 2025, Fr. Denny Labat will serve as a mentor to Fr. Beschi while continuing to serve as an administrator to these two parishes through the month of December.

Fr. Brendan Rolling will serve as Pastor of Ss. Peter and Paul in Ivanhoe, St. Genevieve in Lake Benton, St. Dionysius in Tyler, and St. John Cantius in Wilno, residing at the rectory at Ss. Peter and Paul's in Ivanhoe. Fr. Brendan will also devote 25% of his time to his responsibilities as Diocesan Director of Seminarians.

Fr. Cornelius Ezeiloaku will serve as Parochial Vicar for the parishes of the Christ the King AFC, residing at the rectory at St. Dionysius in Tyler. In addition, Fr. Cornelius will be available as needed to assist with fill-in ministry on the weekends for priests in the diocese who need to be gone on retreat or vacation.

Christ the King AFC will continue to include all six parishes of St. Leo in St. Leo, St. Peter in Canby, Ss. Peter and Paul in Ivanhoe, St. Genevieve in Lake Benton, St. Dionysius in Tyler and St. John Cantius in Wilno, sharing resources, priest salaries, and staffing as currently practiced.


