Living Our Faith, Building our Future

During the years of 2023-2024, every Catholic Church in the Diocese of Fargo is asked to participate in the Diocesan fundraising initiative entitled *Living Our Faith, Building our Future*. This is the first Diocese-wide capital campaign in thirty years. The \$20 million goal for the diocese will benefit many wonderful projects including updating Maryvale Retreat Center in Valley City, the Priest Retirement Home in Fargo, and a boost to the diocese's priest pension fund.

Here at St. Aloysius and St. Vincent we will be participating this spring. The fundraising goals that have been set for the parishes are: St. Aloysius—\$167,893 and St. Vincent—\$34,381.

As an incentive for participating parishes, we will keep 30% of what we raise. At St. Aloysius we plan to use the parish portion to fix and renovate the bathrooms on the property. At St. Vincent, the money will go toward new external doors for the church.

There will be more updates in the upcoming weeks; but, to learn more about the campaign and ask questions, there will be a reception held after all Masses on the weekend of April 20/21.
