The Gifts of the Holy Spirit

On April 6 twelve young people from our Cluster will be confirmed. They are Laritza Avianeda, Keegan Cavanagh, Santiago DeLaCruz, Dillon Fier, Chase Lee, Parker Messerich, Brenna Meyermann, Alyssa Reuter, Kyle Simmons, Ryan Scheckel, Ella Trenkamp, and Eric Trenkamp. As our responsorial psalm this Sunday declares, "The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy!"

We are grateful to their teachers, Melinda Hackman and Lori Fier, along with Fr. Francis, for preparing them, but all of us have a responsibility to support these young people as they take this important step in their journey of faith. They are being asked to embrace a life of faithful discipleship and to participate more fully in the mission of the Church. We are called to help them.

At their Confirmation, the bishop will make the sign of the cross with holy chrism on their foreheads, and say, "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit," which will leave an indelible mark on their souls. The gift of the Holy Spirit is the completion and perfection of the grace they received at their Baptisms, and we want them to thirst for this grace and understand what the Holy Spirit is about to do for them. We hope that with this grace they will know and feel how being Catholic is about being a certain kind of person -- the kind of person they were created to be.

The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to Catholic Tradition, are character traits Jesus possessed in abundance and freely shares with each of us. They help us grow in holiness, emerging gradually and developing through experience and prayer. As these young people are being confirmed, we need to remind ourselves of the

gifts we, too, were given, because though they were given to us as gifts, it's up to us to put them to good use to strengthen our relationship with God...and help these young people in the process.

<u>Wisdom</u> is the ability to view the world through God's perspective. With it we are able to see and evaluate all things (i.e., joy and sorrow, success and failure) through the eyes of God.

<u>Understanding</u> grants us the ability to comprehend the Scriptures, the messages they hold, and the meaning of Christ's teachings. The more we understand the teachings of the Church, the more our faith is strengthened.

<u>Knowledge</u> helps us determine if we have all of our spiritual facts in order such as: are material objects and idols keeping us from putting God first? Are our sinful ways creating a roadblock between God and us? Where do we need to make changes?

<u>Counsel</u>, also known as judgment, gives us the ability to judge what is good and evil and to act accordingly. It helps us to assess a situation correctly so we are always living our life according to God's will.

<u>Fortitude</u> gives us the mental and emotional strength to face adversity, danger, or temptation. It helps us to persevere in our pursuit of being united with Christ Heaven.

<u>Piety</u> allows us to recognize our total reliance on God and come before Him with humility, trust, and love.

<u>Fear of the Lord</u> means we should fear the horror of sin and how sin separates us from the Lord. We should fear living, speaking, or acting in any way that offends the Lord.
