

Peace Be With You!

"Lord Jesus Christ, who said to your Apostles: Peace I leave you, my peace I give you, look not on our sins, but on the faith of your Church, and graciously grant her peace and unity in accordance with your will." We hear the priest say these words every time we go to Mass, and as with everything else in the Mass, it has great purpose and meaning.

In today's gospel we hear the words Jesus said to his disciples, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you." We know the disciples w, after all they had just abandoned Jesus during his worst days, but Jesus wanted them to know they were forgiven; there was only peace between him and them. It was this forgiveness and peace he told them to preach to all nations.

This is the peace we celebrate and pray for at Mass. The sign of peace we offer to each other during the Mass is meant to be much more than a polite greeting to those around us. When we exchange the sign of peace at Mass, we do so with the same words Jesus spoke to his disciples, "Peace be with you."

With the sign of peace we are meant to encourage one another to know and trust in God's presence, love, and mercy. It's meant to be a sacred moment when the grace of God heals us and passes through us to other parishioners, bringing about a real communion among us as we prepare to receive and share our deepest communion with God in the Eucharist.

Then at the end of Mass, we are told to "go in peace," which means much more than to leave with a good feeling. It means we are to leave church with the intention of making peace happen in our personal lives and the world around us. Our response to this command is "thanks be to God." We are not thanking God that the Mass is over, we are thanking Him for the grace we have received through the Mass and the Blessed Sacrament necessary to do His work in the world.

So now the real work begins, carrying the Gospel message to our families, neighbors, and the world by the faithful witness of our lives. After all, we are the body of Christ, and we have been called to share his message of forgiveness and peace with the world, like the disciples before us. That is how we answer our call to evangelize!
