The means, the only means, she may use are those which are in accord with the Gospel and the welfare of all men according to the diversity of times and circumstances."

Letter from Tom Venzor, October 09, 2024  
"Why Not Vote Against Both Initiatives?"

Dear Advocates,

As voting begins, there's been confusion surrounding the two abortion-related initiatives on the ballot. Some pro-life voters are considering voting against both Initiative 434 and Initiative 439, mistakenly believing that 434 creates a right to abortion in Nebraska's constitution. We are here to assure you that 434 does not create a right to abortion. Importantly, Pope St. John Paul II tells us in his encyclical, *Evangelium Vitae*, (paragraph #73) that Catholics may support incremental laws as we work toward the protection of all innocent life, especially when defending against evil policy proposals like Initiative 439. If Initiative 434 is defeated, it makes way for the unsafe, unregulated, and un-Nebraskan Initiative 439 to prevail. This would result in losing over 50 years of critical protections for human life. Voting FOR 434 and AGAINST 439 are the most important steps we can take to protect Nebraska's women, children, and future generations.

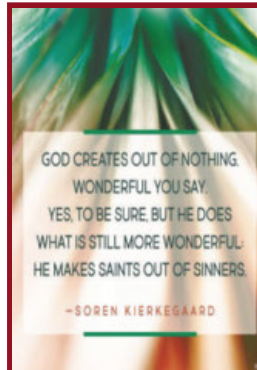

## NATIONAL VOCATION AWARENESS WEEK

November 3, two days after All Saint's Day, we will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation at 12:30 pm. In preparing for the sacrament, we ask those who are to be confirmed to choose a Saint's name. This, choosing a new name when one is confirmed, is rooted in our Catholic tradition as a sign and symbol that those who are confirmed are receiving special graces and gifts to become a different person. If the candidate says yes to cooperating with God's will and grace, he or she is able to serve God in a special way with a new charism. We ask the candidates to research and find a Saint that can inspire them to become closer to God.

I recall when I was young, I read historical fiction books about the lives of the Saints. The Jesuits who were missionaries to the United States were particularly inspiring for me. Now, I am somewhat partial to Padre Pio. Who is the Saint that you look up to? I have heard it said that it helps to find a Saint that has similar interests to us and a Saint that is different than us; to affirm us and challenge us.

This is also the beginning of National Vocations week. Saints Isaac Jogues, Jean de Brébeuf and six other martyred missionaries, all Jesuit priests or laymen associated with them, were all martyred for the faith. They inspired me! I believe that their lives encouraged me considering a vocation to the priesthood.

Imagine all the Saints in heaven enjoying all eternity. If you were to speak with them, I imagine they would tell you that their most important decision, aside from following Jesus, was finding and living their vocation.

Discovering your vocation is answering the question: Who does God want me to bring with me to heaven? St. John Paul II, Pope, states, "Each one of you must be holy also in order to help your brother and sister pursue their vocation to sanctity" (Vianney Vocation Website). So, you



may be wondering what you can do to inspire vocations? In a CARA study of the 2020 ordination class, 89% of the newly ordained priests said they were encouraged to consider the seminary by their parish priest, a friend or another parishioner. That would be all of you reading this. If you see a young man or woman who seems to have that special quality to be a priest or a nun, first pray for him or her. Then, when you have an opportunity, let that person know that you think they would be a good priest or sister, and why. Remember, pray first, then encourage, and then let God do the work!

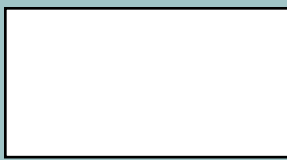
