

# 2 | REBUILDING WITH GRACE: "THE NECK"

It is necessary that a parish is regularly involved in the infrastructure of the facilities, whether it is ongoing maintenance, preventative maintenance, storm damage or other issues as buildings age. But we know that we are more than a building. As a community of faith, it is good to look at the infrastructure of the leadership of a parish. How is the Catholic Church, particularly a parish, structured and governed?

St. Paul in his letter to the Colossians (1:18) defines Christ as the head and the Church as his body. In the Council of Jerusalem (Acts 15; Galatians 2) Paul and Barnabas traveled to Jerusalem to meet with Peter, the other Apostles and the Elders of the Church. Paul had encountered several pastoral problems with those Gentiles who wanted to follow Jesus but did not want to first follow Jewish law. At the Council of Jerusalem, there was a lively debate with no small amount of angry disagreements. The Holy Spirit came upon Peter, the head of the Church, and he made the decision to remove the obstacles to the Gentiles. The Apostle James promulgated the rules that allowed Gentiles and Jews to be together at the same table as the one Body of Christ.

The structure and governance of the Catholic Church is therefore comprised of heads and bodies. The head decides and the body deliberates. There is authority in the head and wisdom in the body. In the list of heads, there is the successor of Peter, Pope Francis. He has a number of consultative bodies founded in Canon Law and magisterial teachings. As the successor of the Apostles, the bishop is the head of a diocese. Like Pope Francis, Archbishop Hebda has a number of consultative bodies founded in the same Tradition and law as the Pope. The bishop delegates the responsibilities for a parish to the pastor. A pastor and his consultative bodies are likewise subjected to the same Tradition and law as directed by the bishop.

What connects the head to the consultative bodies can be seen as a "neck" – the structure that ensures that the legitimate authority of head and the inspiration of the Holy Spirit in the wisdom of the body are together in deliberating the needs of the faithful and collaborating on the good stewardship of the gifts of the people. In accordance with Canon Law (universal) and Archdiocesan policies (local law) each parish functions with two consultative bodies – the Pastoral and Finance Councils.

Minnesota established the law for religious corporations in 1851, before statehood. Subsequently Archbishop John Ireland (Archbishop from 1888-1918) created separate corporate boards for every parish to oversee the civil governance of parishes, also called the temporal matters of the Church, which includes finances. To this day, the same five member corporate board, defined over 150 years ago, serves St. Gerard's: our two Trustees, the Pastor, the Vicar General of the Archdiocese and the Archbishop.

The Finance Council and Pastoral Council are consultative and advisory to the pastor and the corporate board. These consultative bodies were merged during the pandemic as a leadership team and met monthly with the trustees and the pastor. I am grateful for the excellent service of our leadership team during the pandemic and the transition of pastors. Lynn Leonard and Steve Robinson have served as our parish trustees since 2006 and will continue to serve in this important role.

This fall, I will be appointing members to serve five commissions (co-mission) to share in the work of the parish: Liturgy and Worship, Pastoral Care, Social Outreach, Faith Formation and Catechesis, and Community Life. Each commission will select a representative to form the Pastoral Council. Along with the appointed members to the Finance Council, all the leadership of the parish will gather this fall to move forward to have both councils fully operational.

I invite our prayers for our parish leaders. Truly, as we construct the "neck" to connect me as pastor with our parish's consultative bodies, we are rebuilding with grace.


