Dear Parishioners:

On Thursday, September 15th, I hosted a town hall-style meeting to provide an update on the formation of our pastoral and finance councils, introduce our new commissions for sign-ups, provide other opportunities for service and engage in a dialogue on peoples' questions, concerns and comments.

Over 75 people attended. I was most impressed. The questions, concerns and comments were inspiring as they all pointed to how the attendees were committed to the health and well-being of our parish. If that wasn't enough, the sign-ups for the commissions and the other opportunities for parish involvement far exceeded my expectations. It was an evening that can be best explained by one grateful parishioner: "I felt tonight that our parish is back!"

There was great optimism for our ability to rebuild from what had been put on hold because of the pandemic. Yes, we all share the concerns expressed for financial transparency, evangelization of our youth, good communications and ways to include more of our Vietnamese and African parishioners in the life of our parish. Over the next few months, I am looking forward to working with our councils and commissions to make great progress in these and other areas of parish life.

As I said on that Thursday evening gathering of interested parishioners, "God has given us every gift we need to meet any need we will ever have." This statement of faith was realized in the people who were in attendance at the meeting. Yet I am also greatly encouraged that there are many more supportive parishioners who did not attend but are no less committed to the vitality of parish life.

Of course there are challenges. But for now it is a time to rejoice in the treasured gift of the people of the Church of St. Gerard Majella. I offer my prayers of gratitude to God for all of you. I am one lucky pastor!
