## A MESSAGE FROM FATHER

### Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time



There are many voices in our world that compete for our attention. Some voices are louder, and some voices are more attractive. The question for us to consider is how do we respond to the various voices that cry out for our attention? Jesus tells us in the parable of Lazarus and the rich man to do well in this life with the resources at our disposal. It is not just about serving ourselves, but about serving others as well. Destinies in the afterlife are determined by people's actions in this life. After death there can be no exchange between heaven and hell, and it is all determined upon how we choose to live our lives here and now. What we do matters and that should motivate us to listen carefully to the voice of God, which is not always the loudest voice, but surely the voice that quiets our hearts and minds to give the peace that only God can give.

The prophet Amos offers a warning to those who try to trust in the security of the world. Unfortunately, that is a misplaced trust that does not offer any guarantees of securing lasting tranquility. The role of the prophet is to highlight where things are going wrong. It is not to provide all the answers or solutions. God's interventions in our lives are usually only to point the way. The work remains for us to do. We have the responsibility to decide how we respond to the needs of our families, communities, and world.

The prophet always reminds us to live with integrity and that our gifts are not meant exclusively for our own benefit. Our skills and talents are meant to assist others and to improve our communities and nations for the betterment of all people, with a special regard for the marginalized among us. In this world, the most marginalized are the unborn children, which is why we need to speak on their behalf and allow them their God-given right to be born and join our society. To be pro-life is to heed the words of the prophets and recognize the evil of abortion so that we can restore justice where seeds of injustice have been sown.

We are also called to be peacemakers – to quiet the hearts of the unruly and bring tranquility to our community.

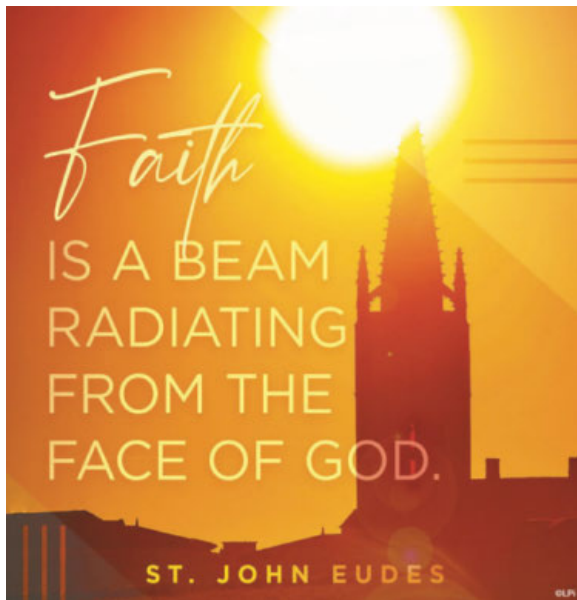
