

# **Welcome to Mary Queen of Peace**



As a follow-up to last week's article, here are a list of the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit. In case you didn't know, the gifts are inscribed in Latin around the church above the stained glass windows. (Fun Fact: because seven is an

odd number, there is one additional inscription in the church besides the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit. See if you can find it! We will publish it in next week's bulletin.)

#### Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Understanding (Intellectus) gives us a deeper insight into the divine truths of faith. It discloses to the soul the hidden meaning of Scripture and reveals the mysterious significance of many of the symbols and figures of our faith. This gift corresponds to the beatitude of the pure of heart. Those who possess purity of heart begin to see God, even now, in all that happens to us

**Knowledge (Scientia)** allows us to judge **correctly concerning the truths of faith** in accord with their proper causes. It makes us see the emptiness of created things and the necessity of placing our complete trust in God. As this gift shows us the gravity of sin, it corresponds with the **beatitude of those who weep for their sins.** 

**Wisdom (Sapientia)** is given that we may **judge and order all things in accord with God's commands**. It is the ability to have the Holy Spirit "see in us" as God sees. This gift corresponds to the **beatitude of the peacemakers** as it gives peace and allows the person who has this gift active in them to bring peace to others in time of trouble.

**Counsel (Consilium)** renders the person docile and **open to God's counsel** with regard to the actions that must be done in light of salvation and one's sanctification. It provides a solution to many difficult situations and problems. This gift is very important for those who must counsel others along their road to holiness. As this gift inclines one's soul to be merciful to others, it corresponds with the **beatitude of the merciful**.

**Piety (Pietas) is** given so that one may give worship to God as our Father. It places in us a true love for God the Father and it arouses in the soul a filial confidence in Him. It also allows us to relate with others as children of the same Father. As such, this gift corresponds with the **beatitude of the meek**.

**Fortitude (Fortitudo)** allows us to **overcome great difficulties** and gives us a power infused by God to endure pain and suffering with patience and joy. It gives the soul relentless strength in the practice of the virtues and overcomes our lukewarmness in the service of God. This gift is related to the **beatitude of those who hunger and thirst after holiness** and never become discouraged in their pursuit of it.

**Fear of the Lord (Timor)** is given that we may avoid sin and attachment to creatures out of **reverence and love of God**. It perfects our hope by preserving us from presumption and it gives us aid against temptations. It corresponds to the **beatitude of the poor in spirit** who possess the fear of the Lord, the beginning of wisdom.




