Mass Intentions—It is the custom of the Catholic Church that priests remember specific intentions at the celebration of the Eucharist. Typically an offering (customarily \$10 in our diocese) is given for a Mass intention.

Anyone can request a particular intention for which a Mass can be offered (for a living or deceased person, or for a special intention—in thanksgiving, for peace, healing, etc.). For the month of **August**, there are **5** openings. If you are interested in scheduling a Mass Intention, please contact Emily at the parish office.





Answer:

We commemorate the faithful departed on November 2nd each year. However, we can and should continue to pray for the dead. Our growth in Christian perfection takes a long time. 


