Becker Building Update

The Mary of the Visitation Finance Council is happy to report that, after an extended process and a few setbacks, we have secured a contract to repair the entrance way at the Becker church. The funds being used are primarily from the insurance settlement from the hailstorm over two years ago. The parish's insurance company paid specifically \$86,500 for the removal of the existing skylight provided we do not replace it, and the reroofing has been paid for through the insurance settlement for hail damage. The Finance Council unanimously voted to use existing building fund savings for the remainder of the balance. The cost for the entire repair is a grand total of \$108,074. The Finance Council also decided to add an automatic door opener for people who have mobility issues for a cost of \$19,827.

The entrance way will replace the current wood doors with 2 sets of thermal glass doors to provide additional sunlight, and the interior of the entrance way will be redone with canned light to provide a brighter illumination. The Mary of the Visitation Pastoral Council was consulted regarding the repairs and unanimously agreed that these repairs should proceed. Our timeline is to begin the work towards the end of September, and it should be completed in 4 weeks. During the repairs, we will be using the unaffected entrances for Mass, Revive and other activities. We are extremely grateful for all the work that has been done to fix this long-standing issue and will always welcome any additional donations to assist with this project.

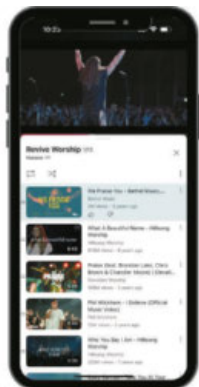

Lectio Divina, Explained!

Lectio divina ("divine reading") is a practice of praying through the reading of Scripture, opening oneself to the inspiration and communication of the Holy Spirit.

The practice of Lectio divina dates to ancient monastic communities, but it has gained popularity in modern times as a way to meaningfully engage with the word of God.

The formula for Lectio divina is simple and follows four steps. The text of the Scripture is read (lectio) multiple times, and the reader takes note of any words or phrases that resonate with him in a particular way. The reader then reflects deeply on the passage (meditatio) and the words that he noticed, turning them over in his mind. Following this, the reader prays with the passage (oratio), and dialogues with God, inviting him to illuminate the reader's understanding of the text. Finally, there is rest and contemplation (contemplatio).

What Happens if Someone Drops a Consecrated Host?

Answer:

Despite our best efforts, and this is as true in our liturgical celebrations as in all of life, accidents happen. Occasionally at Mass, a host may be dropped or some of the Precious Blood could even be spilled from the chalice, despite the best efforts of the priests, deacons, and extraordinary ministers of holy Communion assisting at the liturgy.

So, when a host is dropped or the Precious Blood is spilled, we can take guidance from the U.S. Bishops' statement Norms for the Distribution for Holy Communion Under Both Kinds:

All ministers of Holy Communion should show the greatest reverence for the Most Holy Eucharist by their demeanor, their attire, and the manner in which they handle the consecrated bread or wine. Should there be any mishap — as when, for example, the consecrated wine is spilled from the chalice — then the affected "area . . . should be washed with water, and this water should be then poured into the sacrarium."

According to no. 280 of the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, the general rule is that a dropped host is picked up by the minister distributing Communion and reverently consumed. The minister should be careful to make sure that no other particles from the host remain on the ground. As we see in the instruction from the bishops, the Precious Blood would be absorbed (customarily with a purificator) and the area attentively and reverently washed with water which would then be disposed of properly.

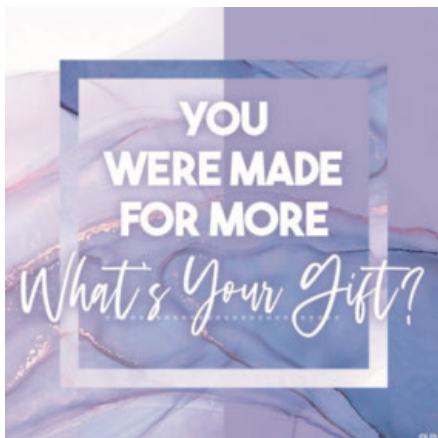
