Please leave your donation in the bins in the vestibule or social hall no later than Sunday, October 13. Gift suggestions, for shoe boxes, but these items can also be donated separately:

Dolls, balls, stuffed animals, small musical instruments, Slinky, play-doh, crayons, colored pencils, coloring books, school supplies, notebooks, paints, barrettes, hair ties, headbands, belts, billfolds, shoes, socks, underwear, bag or purse, bracelets, sunglasses, lip balm, mirror, watch, flip-flops, sweatshirt, sweat pants, nightgown or pajamas, puzzles, books, flashlight, deodorant, hat, scarf, mittens, sewing kit, picture frame, playing cards, puzzles, small blanket, blocks, stickers, kitchen items for cooking and baking, tennis balls, comb, brush, toothbrush, washcloth, small cars and trucks, interactive toys (please include extra batteries), hacky sack, nail clipper, small tools, games, cosmetics, wallets, jewelry, slippers, and batteries
