



A note from the **Most Reverend Leonard P. Blair:**

Circumstances have kept changing over the past two years with regard to precautionary measures at Mass, but some basics are more important than ever and some may need to be reintroduced given that the highly contagious variant is still spreading.

CDC is recommending masks and indoor social distancing again for the time being, and even in the absence of a civil requirement parishioners should asked to wear a mask. Spacing in church should also be maintained appropriately, including the communion line.

For now, it would be best to refrain from unnecessary circulation in church, processions, and from greeting or gathering people before or after Mass.

Unvaccinated persons, however, should not be present in the sacristy, sanctuary or distributing Holy Communion.

And it goes without saying that anyone who has tested positive belongs in quarantine until they have completed the prescribed course of action.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast. All those between the ages of 18-59 are required to fast. Fasting means eating one large meatless meal and two smaller meatless meals and no eating between meals. Liquids are permitted at all times.

Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. All are required to refrain from meat or meat products. Fasting and Abstinence are NOT matters of sin. Do not compromise your health in any way to observe these requirements.

Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday during lent at St. Barnabas Church at 7:00PM

Confessions will be heard on Monday's from 12pm-1pm and 4:30pm-5:30pm during Lent at Saint Barnabas Church.

Funeral Masses cannot be celebrated on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, or Holy Saturday. A funeral service, consisting of the Liturgy of the Word, may be celebrated.


Near-Death Experiences Ouestion:

Are near-death experiences real? Answer:

There is a lot of curiosity and fascination with the idea of an afterlife and communicating with those who have died. In movies, television shows, and numerous books, people make claims about their ability to communicate with the dead, or having had a near-death experience. There is no objective way to verify any of this. While details about people and events can be surprisingly accurate, it is just circumstantial evidence that might be explained in other ways.

On the other hand, when people have unusual experiences, sometimes called near-death or out-of-body, it is real to them. They react with the emotions and thoughts that one would expect. At times, they report details they could not have known any other way, such as bits of conversation, or meeting people they had never known in this life. So certainly, to the person, they experience something. We believe in a life after death, we believe in the communion of saints. These things are not a contradiction to faith, but we should not base our faith on them, nor change our beliefs. They are unexplained and will likely remain so.
