



The Support Group is a small group voluntarily sharing their experiences in restructuring their lives from a loss of a loved one or dramatic change in life. We discuss helpful spiritual guidance and lessons learned from other support organizations.

#### Bereaving the Loss of Normal Life In a changing Pandemic Environment

Bereavement is the process of recovering after a dramatic change in our lives such as a loss of a loved one, a job, a pet and now a Pandemic. We go through similar emotions of denial, anger, confusion and others.

As we managed to go through the holidays, we often start looking ahead, hopefully with a more controlled environment as we learn how to deal with challenges from the COVID Variants.

In this next session we will discuss a paper by Darcie Sims on "Who Am I Now?" As we deal with changes that were imposed on us by events out of our control, we often ask ourselves how to deal with others in this changing environment. Darcie, a bereaved mother, a psychotherapist, and inspirational speaker has 12 specific suggestions that we will discuss on coping with these changes and making sense of them.

#### <u>Does Someone You Know</u> <u>Need a Prayer Shawl?</u>


