The Lord is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia! - We refer to what we have celebrated the last three days (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and at the Easter Vigil) as the Paschal Mystery because from suffering, pain and death come hope and a promise of peace and happiness and life with God for an eternity. Part of the mystery might be why God chooses not to give up on us. Through the Paschal Mystery we come to learn that God is love and his love knows no bounds for those he has created in his own image and likeness. Through the Paschal Mystery we come to learn that sin, death and evil never have the final word. Jesus out of love for His Father and us has overcome all of it by his complete self-sacrifice.

Today we recall God's plan for our salvation. What God created, he created good most especially we who are created in his image and likeness. Jesus' suffering and death reminds us most definitively how much God loves us. His suffering and death should also challenge us to live our lives in such a way that others will see the image and likeness of God through us. Today we renew our Baptismal promises. A new Paschal (Christ) Candle stands tall in the sanctuary representing Christ, the Light of the World. Let us once again resolve to live as children of the Light who have been saved and redeemed by Jesus. Let us not give into the ways of the world, but rather let us bring Christ's Light where there is darkness, hope where there is doubt, and faith where there is fear. Let us bring love and charity to replace selfishness and self-centeredness. *My good people, let us rejoice and be glad for the Lord is Risen Alleluia, Alleluia!! In the name of Frs. Michael, Peter and Raymond, Deacon Don, the entire parish staff, and my own have a very Blessed Easter and Easter Season these next 50 days!*

Welcome! - One of my favorite Polish sayings is, "Gosz w domu, Bog w domu" which means "Guest in the House is God in the House". We indeed are pleased to welcome God today by welcoming you to His house here at St. Paul or Sacred Heart Church. We extend that welcome to all who may be back today visiting family and friends in the area. It is very good to have you here with us.

We also offer a very special welcome to you if you have been away from the Church or the regular practice of your faith. If there has been anything keeping you away from a more regular participation in the life of the parish, the Friars are most willing to help you through whatever that might be and would be most pleased to walk with you. I want you to know that you always have a place here that you can call home.

The following sentence is on the cover of our bulletin every week: "Let the Church always be a place of MERCY and HOPE, where EVERYONE is WELCOMED, LOVED and FORGIVEN." I pray that you know that these words of Pope Francis are meant specifically for you and that it applies specifically to this Parish of St. Paul. We wish that all of you who are here

today would always be with us. We would be so much better if you were here each weekend. We hope that as you would make us better that we too could add to your lives as well. So once again, welcome and thank you for joining us today! We hope to see you again real soon!

Paschal Candle - The preeminent symbol of the Easter season is the Paschal Candle which stands tall in the sanctuary. Lorraine Rakowski has covered the cost of this year's Paschal Candle with a donation of \$290. She has made the donation in memory of Nonie Bolles and Anthony Radavich. Thank you Lorraine very much for your generosity!

Weekday Masses this Week - There is one weekday Mass per day this week. There will be a 7am Mass on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. On Tuesday, the usual Holy Hour will be held at 4pm followed by the 5pm Mass. There is a school Mass on Tuesday at 8:45am which is open to everyone.

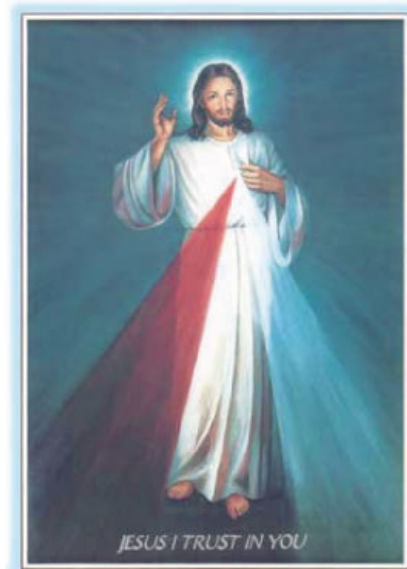

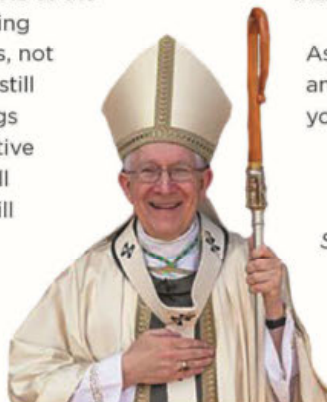
We possess an unshakeable hope because of Jesus Christ. During this Easter Season, as we celebrate the glory of His death and resurrection, let us remember that it

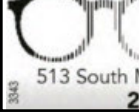
