





### PASTOR'S COLUMN - SUNDAY, MAY 8, 2022 - FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER







HomeFront 2022 In the teachings of Jesus we find a model that shows us how we should treat others as if they were Christ in disguise. Through these charitable actions we help our neighbors with their physical needs. You have the

opportunity to be Christ in Action by participating in our HomeFront 2022 project, a volunteer-driven program that provides free repairs to low-income homeowners thus enabling them to remain in their homes. Volunteers work with professionals to repair, paint, and improve yard conditions.

HomeFront 2022 will take place on **Saturday**, **May 14th** in Kensington for a veteran and his wife. Projects include installing a wheelchair ramp, painting, yardwork, the replacement of a stockade fence and some other smaller projects.
