



Pastoral Council Is Looking for New Members - Since 2017 when Sacred Heart Parish in East Berlin was merged back into St. Paul Parish from which it had been established and then through the COVID-19 pandemic, the normal selection and rotation of members of the Pastoral Council has not interrupted. Parish Raffle Results and Winners - I am pleased to share that we had two of the twenty three winners. Congratulations to Barbara Sagan and Ed Schmitt who each won \$1,000! The full list of winners is on page 6 of the bulletin. There might be some minor final reconciliations, but we sold 2,232 tickets meaning that our net revenue will be \$27,900!! This is 230 more tickets than last year which is more than an 11% increase. The raffle was a tremendous success for our parish thanks to the 581 parishioners who bought and sold tickets which is actually 20 less than last year. Special thanks to June Heffernan, Betty Lasker, Mary Corrigan and Nancy Timbrell for all of their help this year. Five years ago Paul Miano was instrumental in beginning our parish's participation in this raffle. In those five years the parish has raised just over \$104,000. Thank you Paul, and all of the Pastoral Council members who have been so helpful over the five years. Those first two years tickets were sold after Masses for over two months. COVID changed that and as a result, the proceeds have grown since the tickets have been mailed to households. Once again thanks to everyone who supported the raffle and made it such a great success for the parish. Congratulations Ed and Barbara!

School Year Starts - Incredibly our school opens for the new school year this Thursday, August 25th! Let us pray for Mrs. Conaway and the entire faculty and staff that God will bless them throughout this school year so that they will effectively educate our young people in the things of this world (see the next item), but most importantly in the things of God and his Son Jesus Christ. Let us pray too for all of our school children and their parents that this may be a year of growth and grace. Welcome back everyone!

lowa Testing Results - In April all of the students in grades 3 to 7 in our school took the yearly lowa Assessments. Once

again our students had very good scores! Every grade level's composite score is at least 1.5 grades above grade level in their core English Language Arts and Math competencies. Get this, the 7th graders ELA scores were 5.1 grades above grade level. Yes, that's right seniors in high school. Congratulations to the students, teachers, Mrs. Conaway and the entire staff!

Adult Confirmation Program - Please refer to the information on page 9 of this bulletin for information about our six (6) session Adult Confirmation Program that will begin on September 22nd and is for adult Catholics, 18 years of age and older, who have been baptized and received 1st Holy Communion, but have not been confirmed. The reception of all of the Sacraments is about helping us journey through this life to life eternal. The Sacrament of Confirmation is a confirming and strengthening of our Baptisms. Through the Sacrament you are sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and Confirmation provides additional graces to help us live out our adult lives as faithful followers of Jesus and strengthens our bond with the Church. Those who are asked to be a Godparent for Baptism or a Sponsor at Confirmation must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation in order to take on those responsibilities. Likewise, those to be married in the Catholic Church should be Confirmed. Completion of the program would lead to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on Tuesday, November 8th at 7pm at the Cathedral of St. Joseph, Hartford. The deadline to register is September 15.

ADULT CONFIRMATION PROGRAM

Six Session Program Begins September 22, 2022

Are you an adult Catholic who never received the Sacrament of Confirmation? If so, St. Paul's Adult Confirmation Program (ACP) will prepare you to be Confirmed in the Fall of 2022. The reception of all of the Sacraments is about helping us journey through this life to life eternal. The Sacrament of Confirmation is a confirming and strengthening of our Baptism. Through the Sacrament you are sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and Confirmation provides additional graces to help us live out our adult lives as faithful followers of Jesus and strengthens our bond with the Church. Those who are asked to be a godparent for Baptism or a Sponsor at Confirmation must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation in order to take on those responsibilities. Likewise, those to be married in the Catholic Church should be Confirmed.

Who is eligible? Catholics who are at least 18 years old and have already been baptized and received their 1st Holy Communion may participate. If married, you must be in a valid Catholic marriage. If you were married outside the Catholic Church (meaning in a civil ceremony or in a non-Catholic Church without the appropriate permission) and would like to discuss how you can have your marriage recognized in the Church, contact one of the Friar-priests and they will be happy to discuss with you your situation. Your preparation for Confirmation can be done simultaneously with the preparation to have your marriage convalidated in the Church, but the convalidation must be concluded before the Confirmation ceremony. Generally speaking, this can often be accomplished.

When will the program be held? Tuesdays, Sept. 22 & 29 and Oct. 6, 13, 20 & 27 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm at a location at St. Paul Parish to be determined.

What do the sessions entail? Each session will offer instruction on a particular topic through a variety of means, as well as time for reflection, prayer and a time for questions.

What Information must I supply? You must complete a registration form and provide proof of your Baptism and 1st Holy Communion if you received those sacraments at a parish other than St. Paul's. If you are married you also need to provide proof of the marriage.

When and Where Would I be Confirmed? The Archdiocese of Hartford will schedule an Adult Confirmation Ceremony for a date in November at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford.

Who will lead the program? Dan Tome, our Director of Youth Ministry and Adult Catechesis, will lead the sessions.

What is the cost? Just your time and participation. There is no monetary cost.
