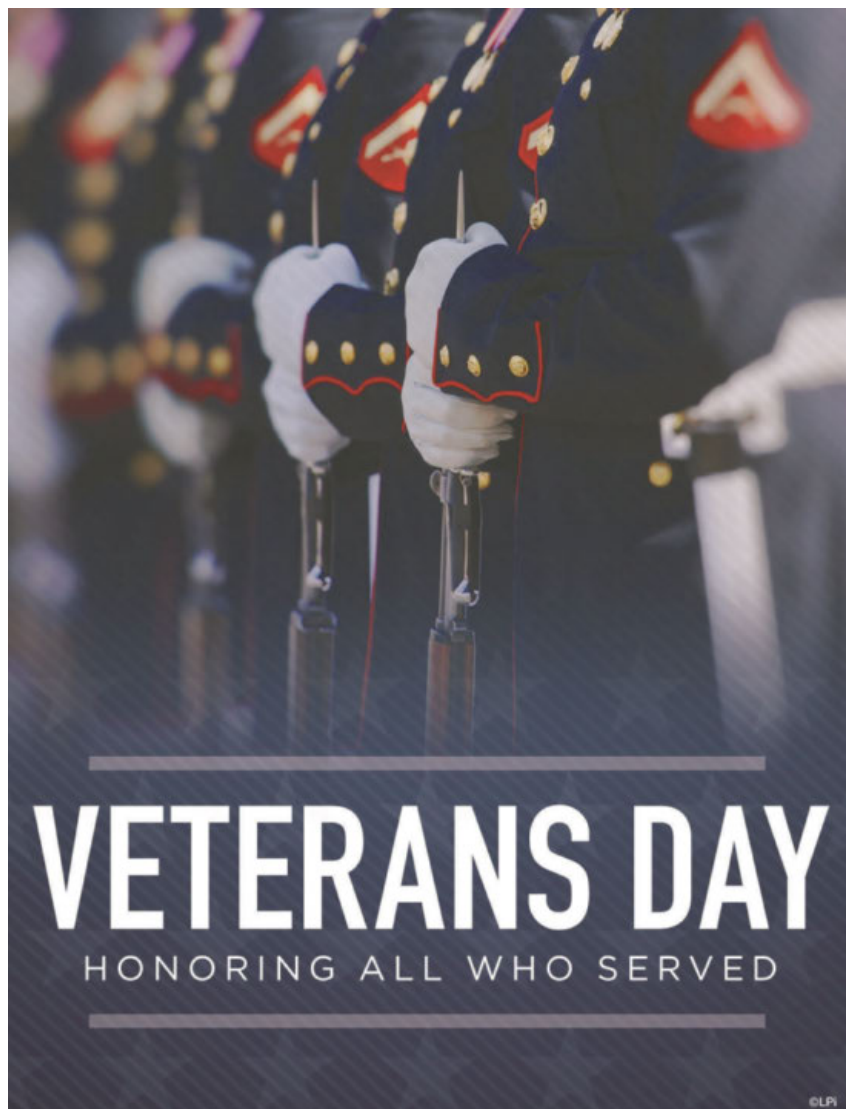

**Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** - We will celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick after all of the weekend Masses on November 19/20. All of the Sacraments, including the Anointing of the Sick, assure us of God's accompaniment through life. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is considered a sacrament of healing and addresses the human reality that as humans we experience sickness, accidents, aging, and disease. While we pray for physical healing we know that we all will eventually die. The most important healing is spiritual healing. In this case, Jesus offers us courage and strength to carry our cross of suffering as he carried His. The Sacrament is not just for those nearing death. So who can receive the Sacrament? To try to answer that question I share this excerpt from the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (1499-1532): *"The Anointing of the Sick is not a sacrament only for those who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for [them] to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. If a sick person who received this anointing recovers [their] health, [they] can in the case of another grave illness receive this sacrament again. If during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious, the sacrament may be repeated. It is fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick just prior to a serious operation. The same holds for the elderly whose frailty becomes more pronounced."* I hope this helps. But if you are still wondering never think twice about asking one of the Friars.

Three or four priests will assist after each of the Masses on the weekend November 19 & 20. Depending on the number to be anointed the service will likely take about 15 minutes. After Mass has concluded all to be anointed will be asked to come to the front of the new wing and be seated in EVERY OTHER row so that the priests can easily come to you for the laying on of hands and the actual anointing with the Oil of the Sick which will take place on your foreheads and the palm of your hands.

I remind all parishioners that you can always approach one of the priests after Mass to ask to be anointed, especially if you know that you have surgery coming up. You can also always call the parish office and arrange for a priest to come to administer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for yourself or a loved one. Human frailty is a part of the reality of life, our loving God is with us through this sacrament to strengthen us when our minds or bodies grow weak. Come and receive the grace the Sacrament offers you.


**Forward With Faith Update** - As was announced last weekend we have surpassed our \$975,000 FWF campaign goal! As of Monday, October 31<sup>st</sup> total pledges and donations now total \$988,798. Having surpassed the goal now the parish will receive 80% of every dollar donated to FWF. We are at 82% of our need of \$1.2 million that was set by our local FWF Cam-

paign Committee. If you have not already made a pledge or donation to our efforts, there is still time to do so. Pledge forms can be dropped off at the parish office, mailed in or you may place them in the collection basket. If you are including a payment please make all checks payable to *Forward with Faith*. Once again thank you to all of the donors and may the Lord bless you abundantly for your goodness!

**Trunk 'O Treat and College Care Package Thank You!** - At last weekend's Masses at St. Paul's, all of the Care Packages for our collegians were before the altar and they were blessed at the end of the 12 Noon Mass. Thanks to everyone whose generosity allowed us to send out over 114 of these packages. The packing process was a well oiled machine as a good group of parishioners were assisted by numerous confirmandi. A big thank you to the Thurston family for their ongoing commitment to this project. Likewise, lots of kids came for Trunk 'O Treat last Saturday on a night that was just perfect weather-wise. Your candy donations were passed out to kids in an array of costumes! A good time was had by all including those who came and decorated their trunks so nicely. The families who brought children to Trick or Treat were asked to bring food for the St. Clare Pantry, and they were quite generous.

**St. Clare Food Pantry** - Thanks to the input from the Trunk 'O Treat and the school families, the pantry is in much better condition this week. Supply was very low as the demand continues to increase, 162 people were served last week. As we are all experiencing the wild increases in food prices, no one has to bring a lot, but just one or two items a week would give the pantry the boost it needs headed into the holiday season. With the help of your generosity we also distribute some gift cards during the holiday season.

**Election Day is Tuesday (Nov. 8)** - "In the Catholic Tradition, responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation" (US Bishops document *Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship* (FC) # 13). While speaking a few years ago at Notre Dame University, the then Archbishop of Philadelphia, Archbishop Charles Chaput, said, "if Christians leave the public square other people with much worse intentions won't." We have an obligation to the society that we live in to make it the best it can be. Polls are open on Tuesday from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Exercising the right to vote is important so take the time to do so on Tuesday. **Parish Raffle Wrap Up** - I wrote this so long ago that I had to re-read it to remember what I wrote. There just has not been room to include it. So once again thanks to everyone who participated in the Parish Raffle this year. Congratulations again to Barbara Sagan and Ed Schmitt from our parish who each won one of the \$1,000 prizes! This year 2,229 tickets were bought, an increase of 227 over last year, resulting in \$27,862.50 for our parish!! This is \$2,837.50 more than last year and is an 11.3% increase. Slightly over 45% of those who were sent tickets made a purchase of at least one ticket which was virtually the same as last year. Recall that St. Roch's and their mailing company made a mistake in sending five tickets to everyone instead of four. Forty-two percent of those who purchased tickets bought all five (5) tickets. Those 244 tickets account for the increase in sales this year. **In the five (5) years that we have been part of this raffle the parish has netted \$104,025. Thank you to the 581 parishioners who participated and made the raffle such a great success!!** Keep Paul Miano, who was instrumental in St. Paul's dive into this raffle, in your prayers.

**Final Thoughts** - I will be headed to Baltimore this week for a few days. In addition to a meeting, I will see family and catch up on some doctor appointments too. As I write this, the Phils have a 2-1 series lead, but by the time you read this, the WS will be done. The Ravens finally had a better second half than first half and came away with a win against Brady. They strengthened their defense at the trade deadline. ### Finance Council Summary

The St. Paul Parish Finance Council met on October 26, 2022, for its regularly scheduled quarterly meeting. Balance Sheets and Income Statements for both the Church and School for the period ending September 30, 2022, were reviewed.

Net Operating income for St. Paul Church and St. Paul School are above budgeted levels although investment performance has decreased the value of Church and School Investments since January 1, 2022.

For the first three quarters of 2022 St. Paul Church operated at a net operating loss of \$35,000 vs the budgeted loss of \$38,000. Net operating income for the full year is expected to produce a small surplus as the fourth quarter usually sees an increase in the weekly offertory as well as the Christmas collection and End of Year (Annual) Appeal. Income for the period totaled \$904,000 and expenses totaled \$938,000.

St. Paul School just completed its first quarter of operations for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2023 with net income of \$67,000. Income, primarily from Tuition, Fund Raising and Development, totaled \$489,000 while operating expenses totaled

Some Sadducees, those who deny that there is a resurrection, came forward and put this question to Jesus, saying, "Teacher, Moses wrote for us, If someone's brother dies leaving a wife but no child, his brother must take the wife and raise up descendants for his brother. Now there were seven brothers; the first married a woman but died childless. Then the second and the third married her, and likewise all the seven died childless. Finally the woman also died. Now at the resurrection whose wife will that woman be? For all seven had been married to her." Jesus said to them, "The children of this age marry and remarry; but those who are deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage. They can no longer die, for they are like angels; and they are the children of God because they are the ones who will rise. That the dead will rise even Moses made known in the passage about the bush, when he called out 'Lord,' the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob; and he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive."

\$422,000.

The Council then reviewed Church and School Investment portfolios. A portion of St. Paul Church and St. Paul School assets are invested in a well-diversified portfolio of stocks and bonds. Church investments at 9/30/2022 totaled just over \$2 million while St. Paul School Investments totaled \$1.3 million. Since the start of 2022 the value of both investment portfolios have decreased approximately 20% giving up a portion of investment gains from previous years. The Finance Council has been monitoring investment results closely, but with results tracking overall market trends it was decided not to make any investment changes at this time.

The Finance Council discussed moving a portion of funds currently in low rate checking and savings accounts into insured Bank Certificates of Deposit or Treasury Bills to increase interest income. CD and treasury bill rates, which had been under 1% in the past are now in the 2 to 4% range.

The Council reviewed the current results of the Forward with Faith Campaign which is approaching its goal of \$975,000.
