The Nativity of the Lord

The Tree and The Crib - On the day Vatican City set up the manger scene and Christmas Tree in St. Peter's Square and a second Nativity scene inside Pope Paul VI Audience Hall, Pope Francis offered a reflection on both, the tree and the crib. Pope Francis remarked that "the tree and Nativity display are two signs that continue to charm young and old." That is certainly true. It is through the manger scene that so much can be taught to our children and serve as a reminder to us about the great blessings of this day. About the Christmas tree, the Holy Father reflected: "The tree, with its lights, reminds us of Jesus who comes to illuminate our darkness" and that people, like trees, need solid roots "because only if it is rooted in good soil can it stay firm, grow, "mature", and resist the winds that shake it.... This is what the Christmas tree reminds us of: to be rooted in Jesus Christ." (Col. 2:7)

The Holy Father then commented about the Nativity Scene. Recall, that it was St. Francis of Assisi in 1223 in the little town of Greccio who began the custom by asking the townspeople to re-enact the birth of Jesus. Our Nativity scenes stem from that re-enactment. Pope Francis said: "the Nativity scene... speaks to us of the birth of the Son of God who became man to be close to each one of us. **In its genuine poverty, the Nativity scene helps us to rediscover the true richness of Christmas.**" "Simple and familiar... Nativity scene recalls a Christmas that is different from the consumerist and commercial Christmas... It reminds us how good it is for us to cherish moments of silence and prayer in our days, often overwhelmed by frenzy. Silence fosters contemplation of the Child Jesus [and] helps us to become intimate with God." Pope Francis went on to say to those gathered that night and to us: "If we truly want to celebrate Christmas, let us rediscover through the Nativity scene the surprise and amazement of smallness, the smallness of God, who makes himself small, who is not born in the splendor of appearances, but in the poverty of a stable. **And to meet Him one must reach Him there, where He is; one must lower oneself, one must make oneself small, leave all vanity behind, to arrive where He is.**"

He concluded his remarks by saying: "**Prayer is the best way to say thank you before this gift of free love, to say thank you to Jesus who wishes to enter our homes and our hearts. Yes, God loves us so much that he shares our humanity and our lives.** He never leaves us by ourselves; He is at our side in all circumstances, in joy as in sorrow. Even in the worst moments, He is there, because He is the Emmanuel, the God with us, the light that illuminates the darkness and the tender presence that accompanies us on our journey."

As the 12 Days of Christmas begin today I encourage everyone, from 1 to 92, to take some time to sit quietly in front of

your Christmas tree and Nativity scene, and consider how much God loves you and wants to be close to you and dispel any darkness in your life. Pray humbly in thanksgiving for this great gift. Let us humble ourselves before the God who humbled himself to come to us to save us and show us the way to the Father. Let us hear and ponder the words of St. John in his First Letter. "We have come to know and to believe in the love God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him." (1 John 4:16) May your memories this Christmas, and always, include how much God loves you and wants to live in and through you. In the name of all of the Friars, Deacon Don, and the entire staff of St. Paul Parish, we wish everyone a very Blessed Christmas. If you are traveling, may your trip be safe be and filled with tidings of great joy! ¡Feliz Navidad!, Joyeux Noël!, Buon Natale!, Frohe Weihnachten!, Wesolych Swiat Bozego Narodzenia!, in other words, Merry Christmas!

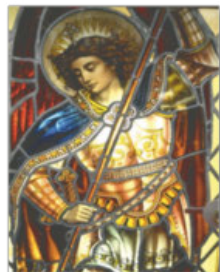

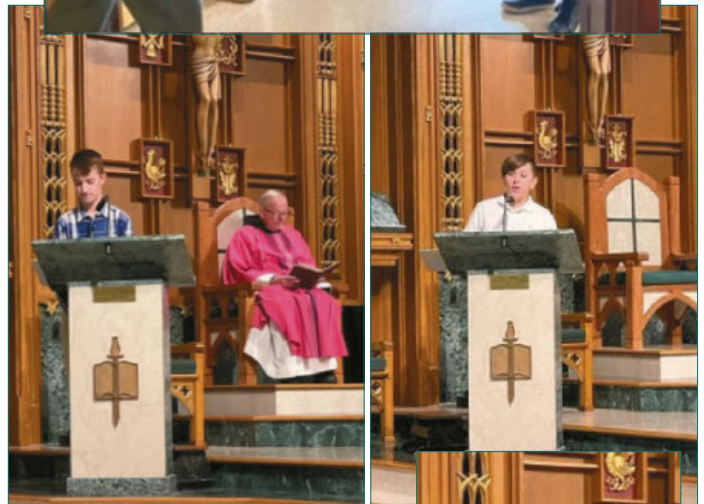
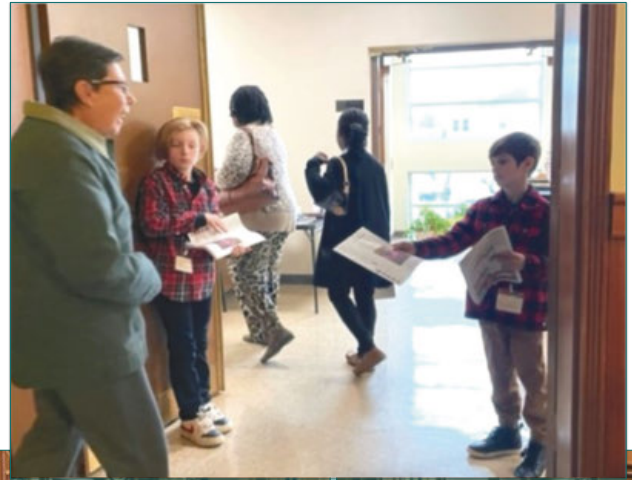

A note from Mary Jane and Mark Duplin:

We are very lucky to be part of St Paul Parish where all of our parish ministries are very active. Some ministries are very visible and can be witnessed very readily. Others are more 'behind the scenes' and are less visible on a day-to-day basis, but the good that is done by any single ministry is of equal value as any other.

St. Paul parishioners and Friars provide a number of social and spiritual benefits to hospitals and facilities outside our parish campus. Sometimes a few ministries join together 'behind the scenes' to do our Lord's work.

A beautiful example of this is our parish presence at the Ledgecrest Convalescent facility right here in Kensington. Generally, the residents will be there for the remainder of their lives. Occasionally, short-term rehabilitation is provided and resolves medical issues that allow a person to return home, but that is the exception to the rule. Most residents there are quite elderly, with little or no family around, and can no longer manage the basic critical tasks of their daily lives. They rely on the nurses and aides to help them with their most basic care. Most also welcome some beneficial and upbeat contact with others outside the facility staff.

On Wednesdays, parishioners from St Paul Parish visit the residents there and recite the rosary with a group of them. It's part social and part spiritual. The folks love the various colored rosaries that are available for their use. This is part of the scope of our Helping Hands Ministry, as well as our Culture of Life ministry.

On Sundays, a group of parishioners visits Ledgecrest, and goes room-to-room socializing with residents and distributing Holy Communion to the Catholics. It is a wonderful thing to be able to bring the Blessed Sacrament to others in need of it and to give them some 'outside' contact for news about the town, the parish, and other things. The residents also receive a copy of the weekly parish bulletin - parishioner or not - and they love thumbing through the pages and seeing the pictures and events of our parish. This Sunday activity brings together efforts of our Eucharistic Ministry, Helping Hands Ministry, and Culture of Life Ministry.

The total time spent in these activities is minimal (30-45 minutes for the Rosary, and 2 hours for the Sunday visiting).

A growing tradition in some Catholic circles involves picking a saint as part of Christmas or New Year's festivities. The randomly chosen patron is asked to watch over us for the coming year, and we are given the chance to get to know one of our heavenly friends better.

It's a great tradition, and one that deserves expanding.

Here's how this could be done:

- The Saints Name Generator: This internet site created by Jenifer Fulwiler enables you to be randomly assigned a saint at the click of a button.

- Get a stack of holy cards ... Divide them like a deck of cards and pick the one on top.
- If you have a copy of Butler's Lives of the Saints, or some other saint book/series with a large selection of saints, open it randomly and select the saint of the page that opens.

Is this a superstitious way to pick a patron saint? Well, it's not as if there's a "wrong pick." No matter who you get, he or she is sure to look down on you with love from Heaven, and is willing to intercede on your behalf.

And anyway, remember how the replacement for Judas Iscariot was chosen?

So they [the remaining Apostles] proposed two, Joseph called Barsabbas, who was also known as Justus, and Matthias. Then they prayed and said, "Lord, you know everyone's heart. Show us which one of these two you have chosen to take the place in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place." And they cast lots for them, and the lot fell on Matthias; and he was added to the eleven apostles. Acts 1:23-26

Here's another idea. Consider a couple of the virtues you would most like (or most need) to grow in this year. Then ask the Holy Spirit to help you find or remember a saint who either really struggled or really excelled at that virtue. In this way, you can specifically put their witness to work in your life.

There are thousands and thousands of saints — and they come from every possible type of background and situation, bringing every possible type of personality, strength, and weakness to their love for the Lord. There's one — nay, many more than one — who will make you stop and say, "Gosh, he or she is a lot like me." Find that person and put them to work on your behalf.

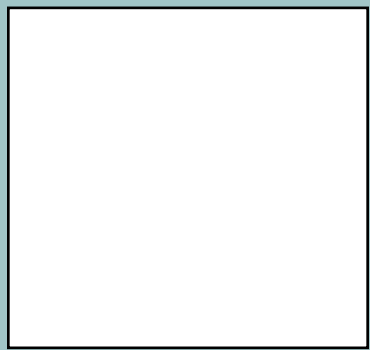

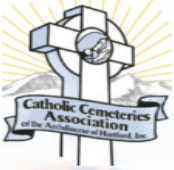
